SUBJECT:	2020 Regional Solicitation: Incorporating Regional Bicycle Barriers

The Council recently updated its <u>Regional Bicycle Barriers Study (RBBS)</u> as recently presented to the TAC at its June 5, 2019 meeting. The Transportation Policy Plan (2018 update) also established Regional Bicycle Barrier Crossing Improvement Areas and Major River Bicycle Barrier Crossings (MRBBC) as a "high priority for federal transportation funds."

At the July 3 TAC meeting, members were presented with three possible options for incorporating the RBBS results into criterion 4A under the multi-use trails and bicycle facilities category of the 2020 Regional Solicitation.

As a result of the ensuing discussion, one option was retained for further consideration and a new option was proposed. The retained option was Option A, "Sum of Two Parts" with a 70/30 split in possible points considered for bike network gaps and local barriers, and regional barriers (based on the RBBS barrier crossing improvement areas), respectively. The new option proposed (Option C) is an "Either/Or" option consisting of a qualitative assessment of local factors (also included in Option A) and a separate quantitative assignment of points based on the RBBS crossing areas and Major River Bicycle Barrier crossings; projects would be awarded the higher of the two component scores.

Further details, including a comparative analysis of the hypothetical impacts of either option with respect to the 2018 solicitation, will be presented as requested (see Powerpoint presentation in full packet). Based on input to be received from TAC members, staff will incorporate one of the scoring options in the draft Regional Solicitation application to be approved by the TAB in September.

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
