2040 Transportation Policy Plan (TPP) Amendment Requirements

Amendment required due to project type:

- Additional lanes on to US 10, a principal arterial
- Constructing a new interchange on US 169, a principal arterial
- Additional lanes on I-94, a principal arterial
- Constructing an interchange on MN 65, a principal arterial
- Grade separations/interchange construction on MN 13, a principal arterial

Highway projects are added to the fiscally constrained TPP when the following criteria are met:

- Documentation is submitted showing how the project can be built with revenue in the fiscally constrained plan (or reasonable proposed additional revenues);
- The proposal is consistent with the goals, objectives, and strategies of the 2040 TPP; and
- Public involvement is conducted.







Corridors of Commerce: Gov. Waltz Announcement on July 12, 2023

\$212 million to 4 projects in the MPO Planning Area

"We're making historic investments in our state's transportation system to improve the safety and connectivity of communities across the state," said Governor Walz. "We depend on our roads and highways to safely get us to our jobs, education, child care, and businesses. These projects help grow our economy and support our goal of making Minnesota the best state to live, work, and grow up in – no matter where you live."


- MN Highway 13 Grade Separations \$96 million
- I-94 Albertville to Monticello project \$78 million
- MN Highway 65/117th Ave interchange project \$30 million
- US 10 project \$8 million

The Met Council wrote letters of support for the four projects listed above as part of the application process. The first three projects were added above were added to the TPP amendment after TAC Planning given the timing of the Corridors of Commerce announcement.





 - State Bonding











MN 65 & 117th Avenue Interchange Project in Blaine

 - Trunk Highway Bonds
 - Regional Solicitation Funds
 - Federal RAISE Grant






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MN 13 Grade Separations in Savage and Burnsville

 - Regional Solicitation Funds






Recommended Motion
