What is a TIP

- Four-year list of transportation projects funded in whole or part with federal funding
- Must include all projects funded with federal transportation funds and projects that affect air quality prioritized by year
- Required for all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)
- Incorporated into MnDOT's Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)

Past and Upcoming Milestones

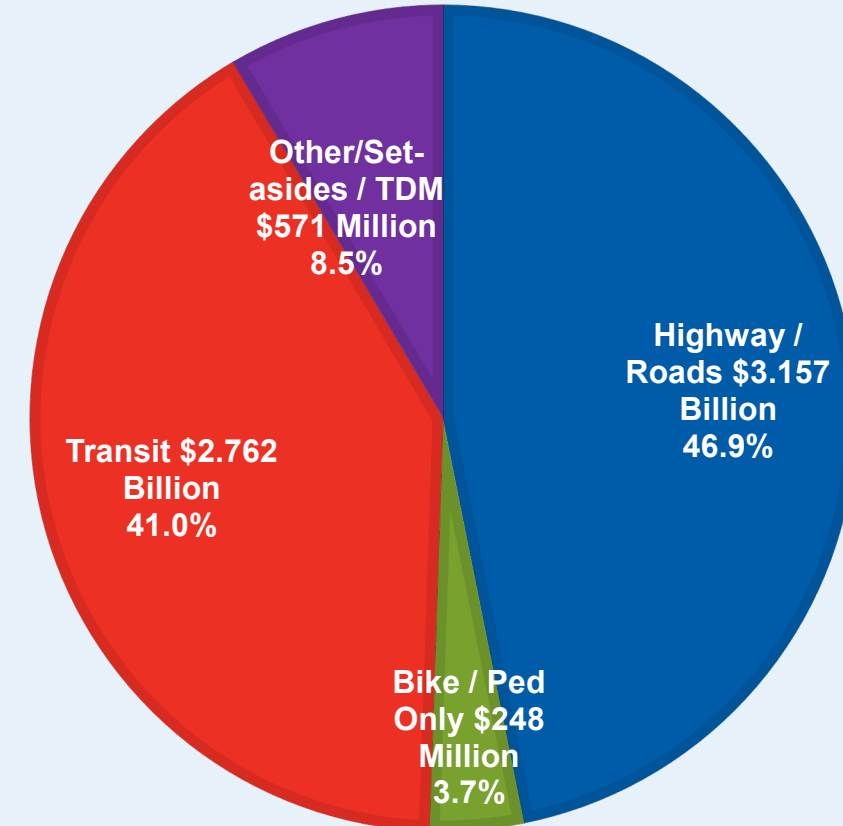
- TAB released draft for public review – May 21, 2025
- Virtual public meeting – June 17, 2025
- Public review/comment period ends – July 7, 2025
- TAB considers comments, recommends approval – August 20, 2025
- Transportation Committee recommends approval – August 25, 2025
- Metropolitan Council approval – September 10, 2025
- MnDOT inclusion into STIP – September/October 2025
- Federal approvals – November/December 2025

Four-Year Summary

Source of Funds

- Federal Highway – \$1.8 Billion
- Federal Transit – \$1.2 Billion
- Property Tax and State Taxes – \$2.5 Billion
- Trunk Highway Funds – \$884 Million
- **Total – \$6.4 Billion**

Transit in the TIP

The TIP includes all transit projects with federal funding, both capital and operating.

- Projects funded with federal formula funds.
- Transit projects funded through the Regional Solicitation with CMAQ funds.
- Federal Transit Administration and DOT competitive grants awarded to the Council and others.
- FTA New Starts/Small Starts
