



Preserves existing network




Funded through sustainable means

- Efficient use of tax dollars today and long term


There are never enough lanes.

We know how to achieve the vision but lack the added funding to do so.








To address the transportation network improvements and make strategic investments over the next 20 years, an additional \$50* billion needed.

...of which \$12 billion is needed for state highways and bridges, alone.




Inflation Impact on Future Buying Power




Projected Revenue Adjusted for 5% Inflation
