Transportation Data Tracking

- Highways
 - Does the plan expand existing roadways/build brand new roadways (beyond local roads)?
- Transit
 - Does the plan have any unique strategies identified that do not originate from the council plans?
 - Are the increased revenue scenario transitways included?
- Biking
 - Does the plan reference a separate adopted bike plan?
 - Does the plan have specific policies or strategies related to biking?

Transportation Data Tracking

- Ped/Walking
 - Does the plan have specific policies or strategies related to walking?
 - Is the bulk of the plan located in the Transportation or Parks section?
 - Does the plan reference or incorporate safe routes to school plans?
- Miscellaneous
 - Does the plan discuss Connected Automated Vehicles?
 - Does the plan discuss Drones?
 - Does the plan discuss transportation safety (including crash data)?

Themes in the Plans

- Some common missing items to date:
 - Forecasts for roadways not consistent with Met Council forecasts
 - Regional Bike Transportation Network (RBTN) not addressed
 - Pedestrian needs not addressed
 - Incorrect Transit Market Areas
- Many plans have addressed most of the checklist items
 - Many plans have excellent mapping
 - Some plans have incorporated the RBTN in their local bike system
 - Most plans have addressed the required aviation components
