RBTN Updates

Administrative Adjustments

- Planning agencies notified of opportunity to request RBTN administrative adjustments in April
- Administrative adjustments were defined to include
 - Alignment designations within existing RBTN corridors
 - Minor extensions up to one-half mile long that provide missing connections to RBTN alignments, regional trails, or regional destinations
 - Minor alignment or corridor centerline shifts that continue to serve regional destinations served by the initial alignment or corridor.

Adjustment Requests

Requests for network adjustments were received from three agencies under the following categories:

- Corridor shifts (4)
- Corridor extensions (1)
- Alignment shifts (8)
- Alignment extensions (5)
- Tier upgrades (not eligible) (2)

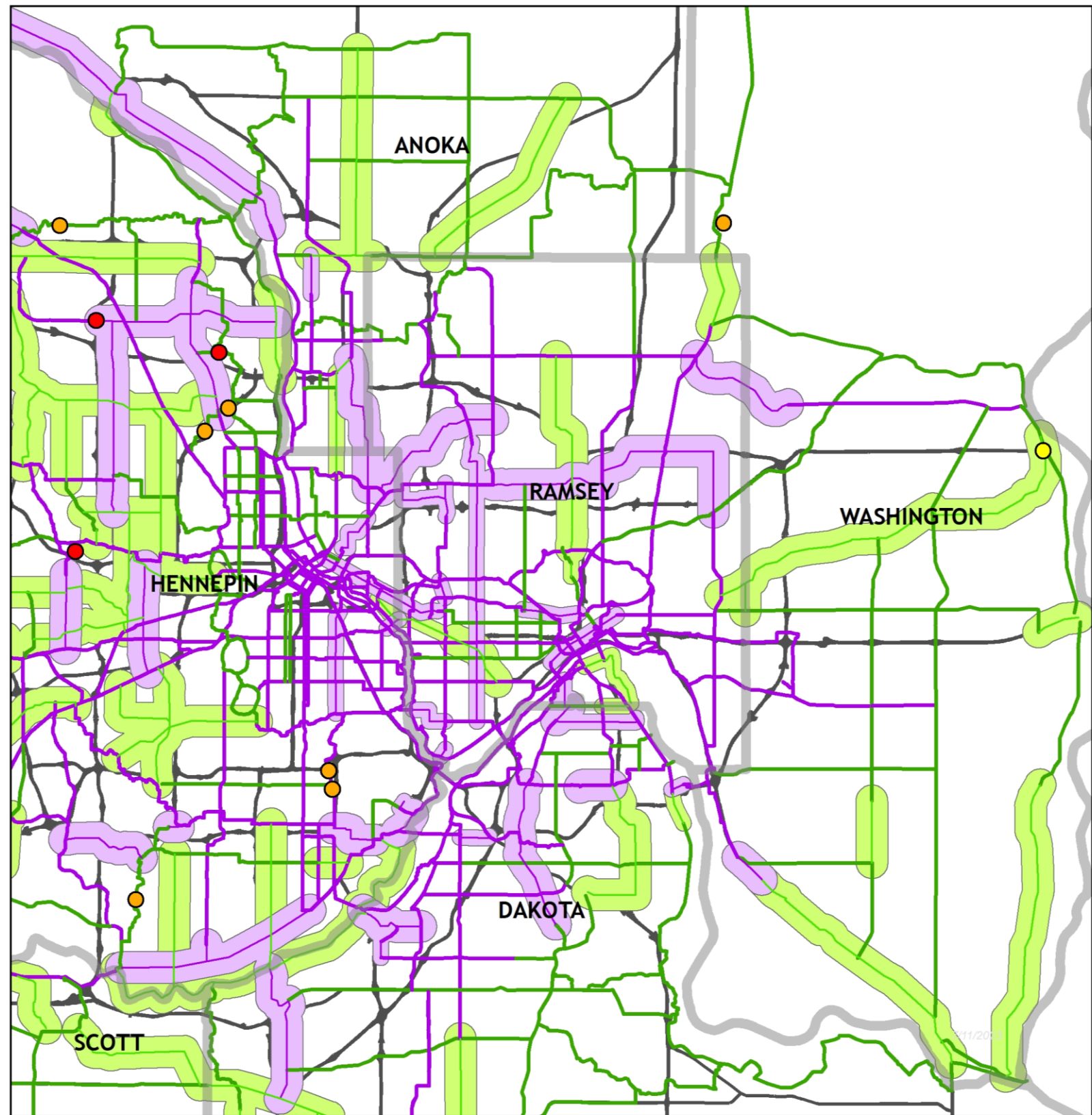
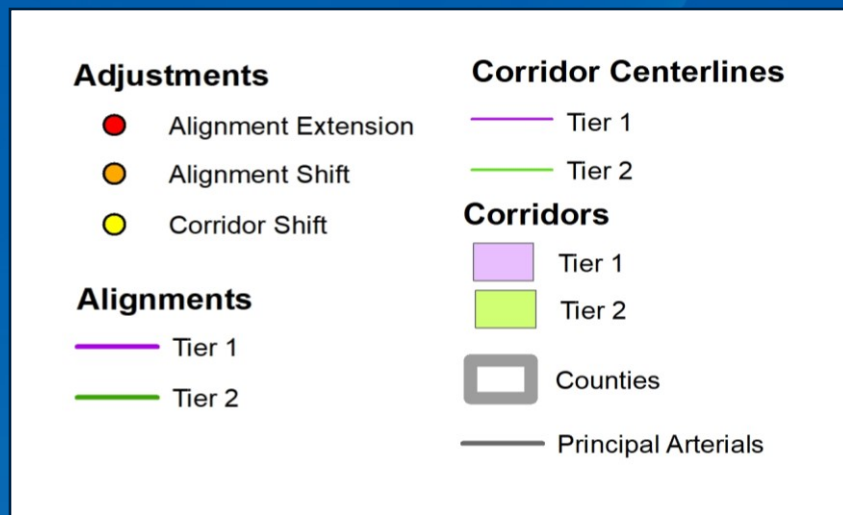

Results

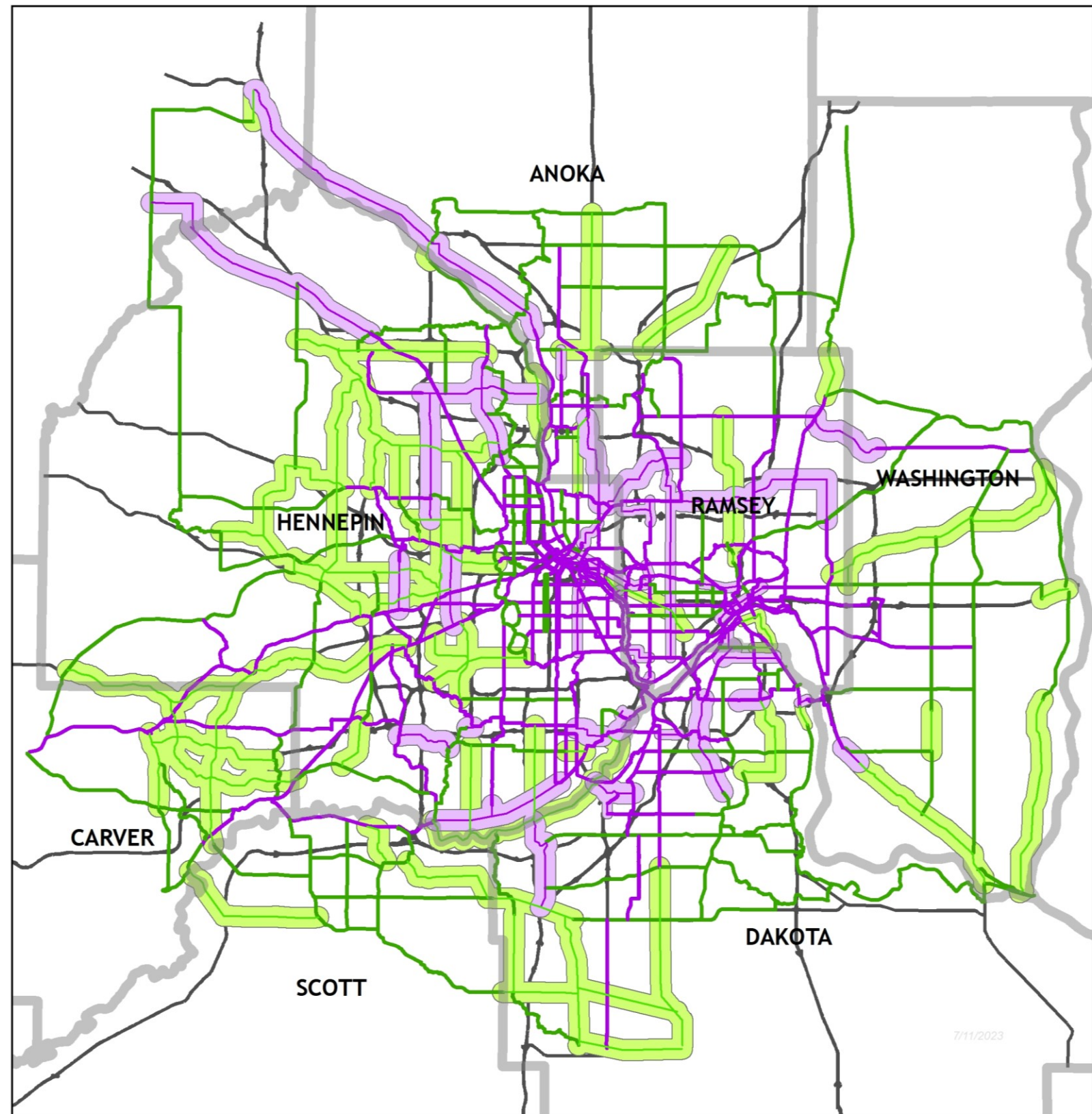
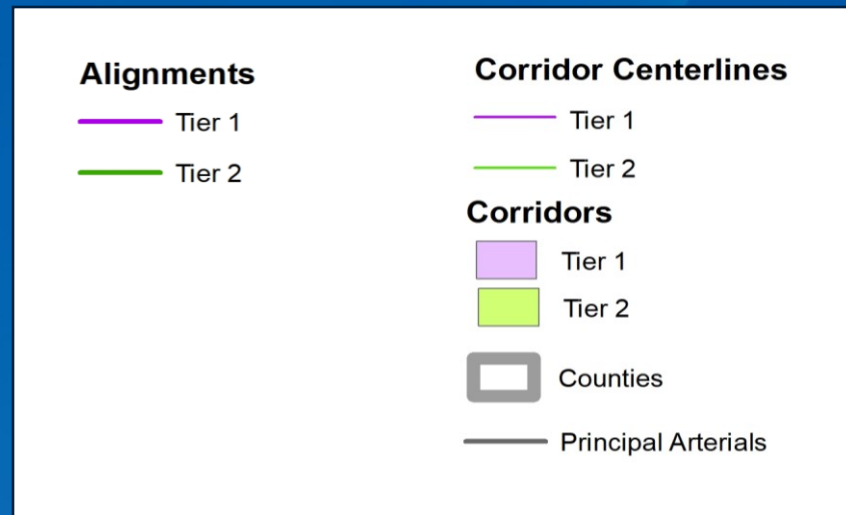
- Worked with requesting agency's staff to confirm details of requests and to clarify decision rationale.
- Of the 20 network changes requested:
 - Accepted and incorporated (11)
 - Deemed “not eligible” (6)
 - Not accepted* (2)
 - No change needed (1)
- For requests that were not accepted or not eligible, proposed changes are documented for possible future updates.

* Non-acceptance due change requiring coordination and acceptance from other local agencies and/or reducing access to designated regional destinations.
