#### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute a contract with Loram Maintenance of Way, Inc for Rail Grinding Services on the Blue Line Light Rail System in an amount not to exceed \$310,582.00 over a one-year period.

### Background

Rail grinding to remove rail surface defects and improve ride quality is a common maintenance activity used by both heavy rail and light rail transit systems. Rail grinding services are needed on the Blue Line Light Rail System to correct areas of developing rail surface roughness. Metro Transit issued a formal Request for Proposals on August 8, 2012 to provide rail grinding services on 65,302 feet of rail to remove surface roughness. Two proposals were received on September 24, 2012; these proposals were rated by an Evaluation Panel. See below for the Evaluation Panel Summary:
