Central Station Vertical Circulation Project

Rendering of Vertical Circulation Project



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Background

- Five bids received
- Value ranged from \$1,769,620 to \$1,842,000
- Estimate for work was \$1,675,011
- Staff reviewed and concluded PCL Construction bid of \$1,769,620 is fair and reasonable



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Proposed Action



- Award and execute a contract with lowest responsive and responsible bidder, PCL Construction Services, Inc. in amount of \$1,769,620
- Exempt anticipated change order, funded by City of St. Paul, for inclusion of public art in the project from 5% delegated change order authority

Background



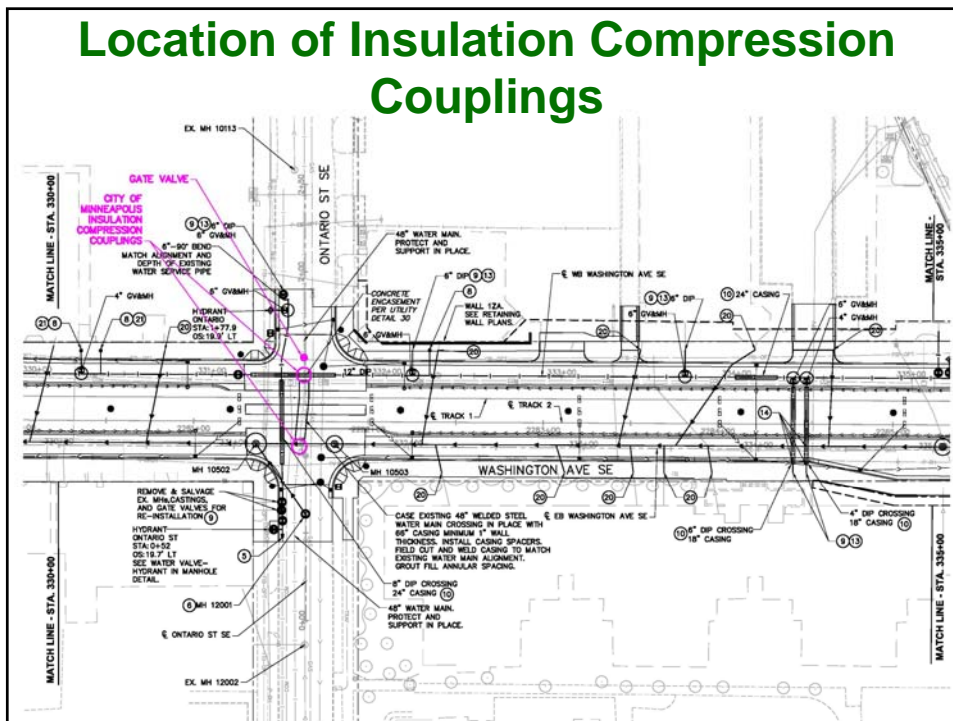
- Installation of isolation couplers and a new valve

- Located in the intersection of Ontario Street SE and Washington Avenue SE

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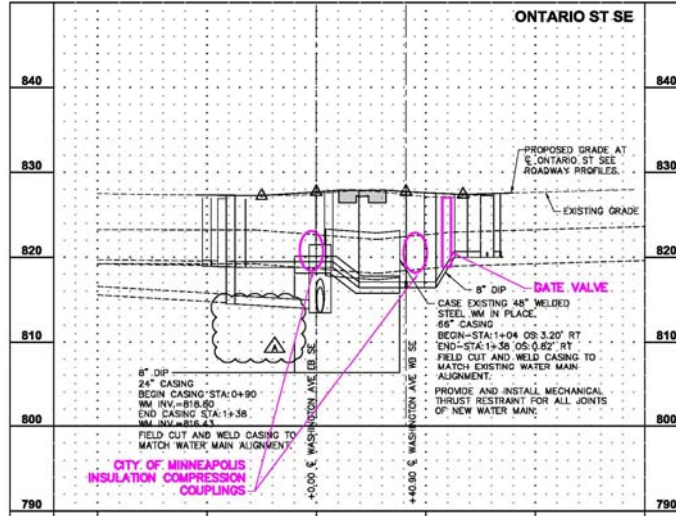
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Location of Insulation Compression Couplings

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Proposed Action



- Negotiate and Execute a Subordinate Funding Agreement (SFA) #22 with City of Minneapolis, in an amount not to exceed \$425,000 under existing Master Funding Agreement to reimburse Minneapolis for installation of isolation couplers and new valve for stray current
