- The Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964
 - No Person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance."

Title VI Compliance Cont'd

- Metropolitan Planning Organization Requirements
 - Service Area Demographics
 - Incorporating Title VI Principles in Regional Planning
 - Distribution of State & Federal Funds
 - Distribution of FTA Funds to Sub-recipients
- New Information
 - MPO requirements
 - Reviewed distribution of federal funds to ensure allocations made fairly & equitably
