
- Washington County Board (June 17 letter)

- Comments and proposed responses were included in June 24 Transportation Committee information item
- Proposed responses to comments #21, 22, 24, 25, 29, 34, 35 revised
- Address new CTIB comment on including CTIB's Phase I Program of Projects

#21 Delay Release of Draft 2040 TPP for Public Comment

- Original response indicated Draft 2040 TPP would be released on July 23rd
- Due to new proposed revisions, draft will be released on August 13th
- Information item presentation to TAB on July 16; additional discussions planned in Aug. and Sept.

#22 and #24 Revise Transitway Maps

- CTIB and Washington Co. commented that :
 - The maps lack regional balance
 - Corridors shown do not match CTIB's map
- Revised Response:
 - Current revenue scenario map includes projects with an LPA; Gateway will be added as a contingent LPA
 - Increased revenue scenario map is balanced and includes all corridors being studied/considered
 - Corridors on both maps have been lengthened and North Central corridor added to align with CTIB corridors



#25 and #29 Transitway Prioritization

- CTIB and Washington Co. Board comments:
 - Prioritization should be driven by major funders
 - Request that prioritization of transitways be removed
- Revised Response:
 - Agree funding partners should drive decisions;
 shared funding sources requires prioritization
 - Add language clarifying CTIB corridors on Transitway map are consistent with TPP
 - Prioritization will not be used to find projects inconsistent with TPP

#33 and #34 Gateway Corridor LPA and I-94 MnPASS

- Washington Co. and CTIB request Gateway corridor LPA be included
- Remove I-94 as Tier III MnPASS corridor
- Revised Response:
 - A contingent Gateway corridor LPA will be included pending a vote by Gateway Corridor Commission in July identifying the LPA
 - Public review and comment process continues
 - LPA report is completed and made available

#33 and #34 Gateway Corridor LPA

- Revised Response cont:
 - CTIB votes on its Program of Projects identifying Gateway as a Phase I project and expected funding shares
 - LPA design minimizes impacts on I-94 right of way to preserve future highway capacity option
 - Text added to indicate removal of I-94 MnPASS lane if Gateway LPA adoption precludes project

New Comment: Add CTIB Program of Projects

- CTIB requests that it Phase I Program of Projects be recognized in the current revenue scenario and map
- Response:
 - Gateway LPA and funding sources added
 - Robert St., Riverview, Red Line Phase II and Red Rock corridors recognized as Phase I projects for CTIB funding and acceleration
 - Remaining CTIB corridors appear on Increased Revenue Scenario map

New Public Comment Schedule

- June 18 TAB recommend draft with comments
- June 23 and July 14 Transportation Committee review partner agency comments recommend response
- July 28 Transportation Committee recommend draft for public comment
- August 13 Council release draft for public comment
- August 18 Public notice; review and comment period begins
- September 17 Public Hearing at Transportation Committee
- October 1 Public comment ends
- October 15 TAB review proposed response to comments
- October 27 or 29 Council review response to comments
- November 19 TAB recommendation for approval
- November 24 Transportation Committee recommendation for approval
- December 10 Council approval
