






Origins of TOD Initiative


TOD policy – Five strategies

Internal TOD working group

- Implement the TOD Policy
- Align efforts to achieve Council TOD goals
- Ensure consistency across TOD-related activities
- Share information and resources about TOD-related activities across the organization





PRO TOD Working Group

- Meet regularly
- Provide input on TOD direction
- Learn together and advance the practice of TOD
- Coordinate with other PRO working groups:
 - Regional Equity and Community Engagement
 - Shared Prosperity





TOD Office


- Manage development projects
 - Joint Development projects
 - Disposition TOD projects
- Be first point of contact on TOD for partners
- Coordinate internally on TOD projects, programs, & issues
- Staff PRO TOD, our external partnership group
- Monitor & report on implementation of TOD Policy
- Represent TOD interests to partners and the public



Current TOD office work plan

- Analyze current and future station areas to identify potential TOD opportunities, especially on Metro Transit properties
- Manage TOD projects
- Provide technical assistance to Transitway projects, as needed
- Convene internal and external TOD groups
- Processes & procedures to implement TOD Policy
 - Internal Working group alignment of programs to TOD Policy
 - Guidelines for Joint Development projects
 - Development roles & process outline for all TOD projects
 - Reporting structure for both policy implementation and projects
