Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council concur with the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) action to amend the 2015-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to modify the 2015-2018 TIP to reflect a requested scope change to its CMAQ-funded project, Nine Mile Creek Trail East. The change would include a new alignment and project termini (SP# 090-090-078 and 091-090-078AC).

Background

Three Rivers Park District was awarded federal funding in the 2011 regional solicitation for this project. The amendment adjusts the trail's alignment and modifies the project termini. The eastern terminus will now be Doron Lane. It will run to Parklawn Avenue and from Edina Promenade along Xerxes Avenue South to 75th Street West.

Note that TAB approved this amendment as part of the 2014-17 TIP. Because this TIP is about to be retired in favor of the 2015-18 TIP, the Council action concurs with the TAB action to reflect a project scope change, but amends the 2015-2018 TIP rather than the 2014-2017 TIP. As of October 23, 2014, the FY 2015-2018 TIP is still in federal review. Should this amendment be accepted by the Council prior to federal approval of the 2015-2018 TIP, it will not be official until after that federal approval is granted.

Rationale

The Transportation Advisory Board approves formal amendments to the TIP and the Metropolitan Council concurs with the action of the TAB. The project is consistent with the Transportation Policy Plan (TPP) and meets fiscal constraint because the state, local and federal funds are sufficient to fully fund the project. The Minnesota Interagency Air Quality and Transportation Planning Committee determined that the project is exempt from air quality conformity analysis.

Funding

The project is fully funded with the federal, and local funds.

PROJECT BACKGROUND:

1. Briefly describe why amendment is needed (e.g., project in previous STIP but not completed; illustrative project and funds now available; discretionary funds received; inadvertently not included in TIP).

The TIP is being amended to adjust alignment and termini to a project (SP 091-090-028; SP 091-090-028AC) in SFY 2015 and 2016 of the 2015-2018 TIP. The Nine Mile Creek Regional Trail: East Segment will shift its alignment in several places and change its termini. Current termini are Tracy Avenue to France Avenue/Edina Promenade. Updated termini would be Doron Lane to Parklawn Avenue; France Avenue S. to Edina Promenade; and Xerxes Avenue from Edina Promenade to 75th Street West.
