What is a TIP?

- Four-year list of transportation projects funded in whole or part with federal funding
- Must include all projects funded with federal transportation funds and projects that affect air quality prioritized by year
- Required for all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)



Key Criteria for TIP and Amendment Approvals

- Consistent with expected funding level fiscally balanced TIP
- Consistent with regional transportation plan
- In conformity with Clean Air Act requirements
- Opportunity for public input




Schedule for 2015-2018 TIP

- TAB approves draft for public review June 18, 2014
- Public review/comment period ends Aug 8, 2014
- TAB considers comments, approval Aug 20, 2014
- Transportation Committee September 8, 2014
- Metropolitan Council concurrence September 24, 2014
- MnDOT inclusion into STIP September/October
- Federal approvals November 2014
