What is a TIP?

- Four-year list of transportation projects funded in whole or part with federal funding
- Must include all projects funded with federal transportation funds and projects that affect air quality prioritized by year
- Required for all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)

Key Criteria for TIP and Amendment Approvals

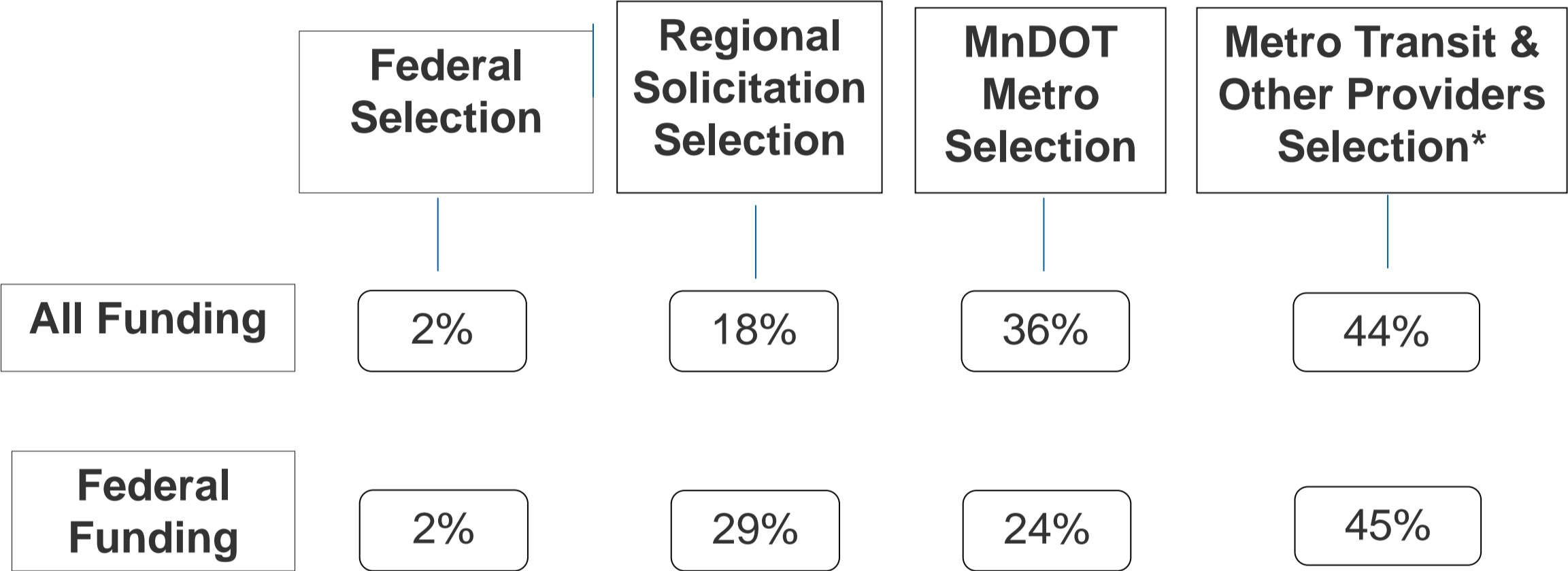
- Consistent with expected funding level – fiscally balanced TIP
- Consistent with regional transportation plan
- In conformity with Clean Air Act requirements
- Opportunity for public input

Schedule for 2015-2018 TIP

- TAB approves draft for public review – June 18, 2014
- Public review/comment period ends – Aug 8, 2014
- TAB considers comments, approval – Aug 20, 2014
- Transportation Committee – September 8, 2014
- Metropolitan Council concurrence – September 24, 2014
- MnDOT inclusion into STIP – September/October
- Federal approvals – November 2014

Source of Funds 4-Year Summary

- Federal Highway – \$945 Million
- Federal Transit – \$716 Million
- Property Tax and State Taxes – \$1 Billion
- Trunk Highway – \$762 Million
- **Total – \$3.6 Billion**
