SIP Purpose

- Long-range bus service expansion plan that identifies system improvements that best achieve regional goals:
 - Transportation system stewardship
 - Safety and security
 - Access to destinations
 - Competitive economy
 - Healthy environment
 - Leveraging transportation investment to guide land use





SIP Purpose

- Engage stakeholders and the community
- Combine regional vision, transit planning principles and public input
- Create a specific, prioritized list of potential improvements when additional funding is available
- Relate to Regional SIP process
- Include in 2015 legislative program
