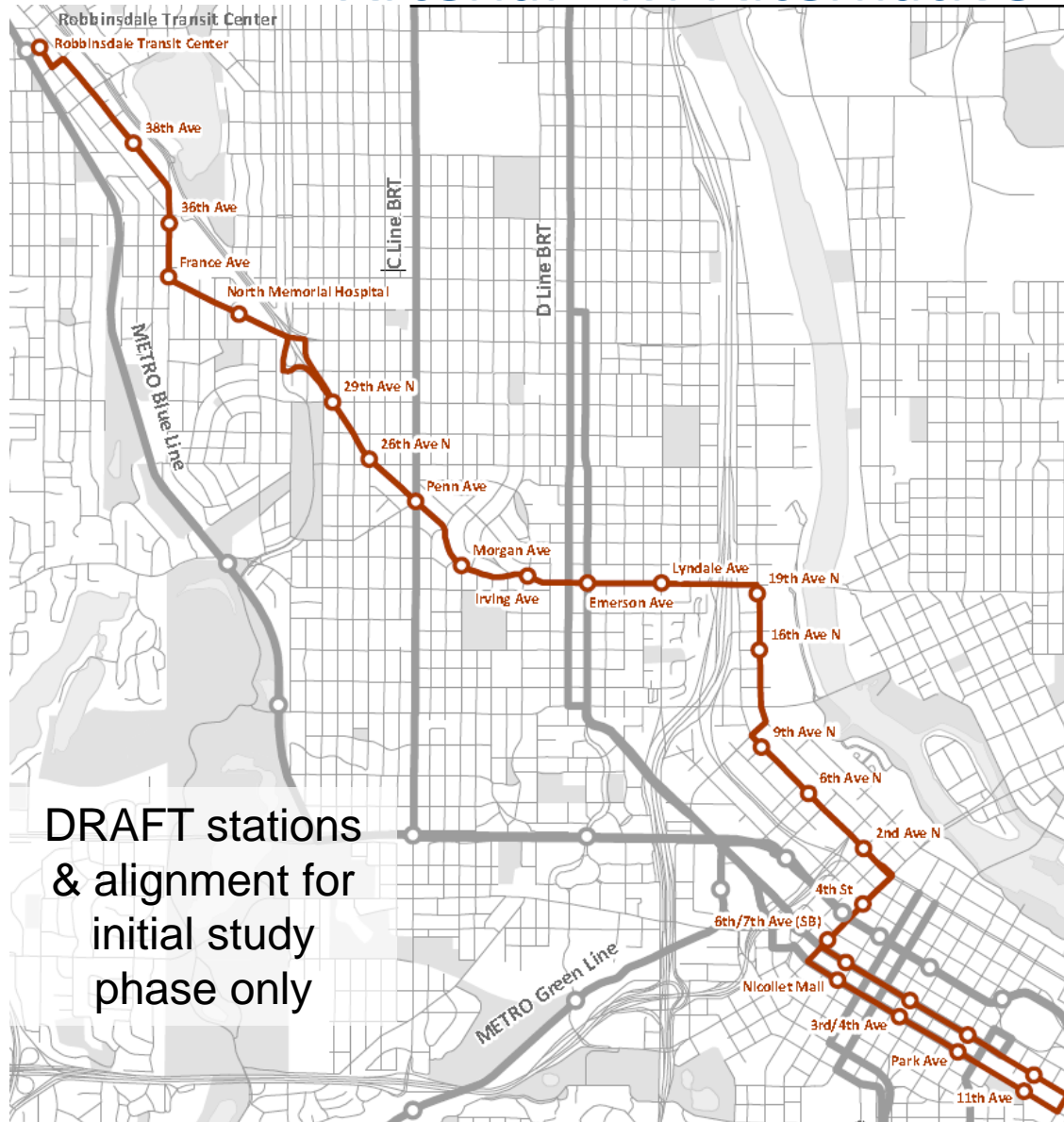




## Study Area Map

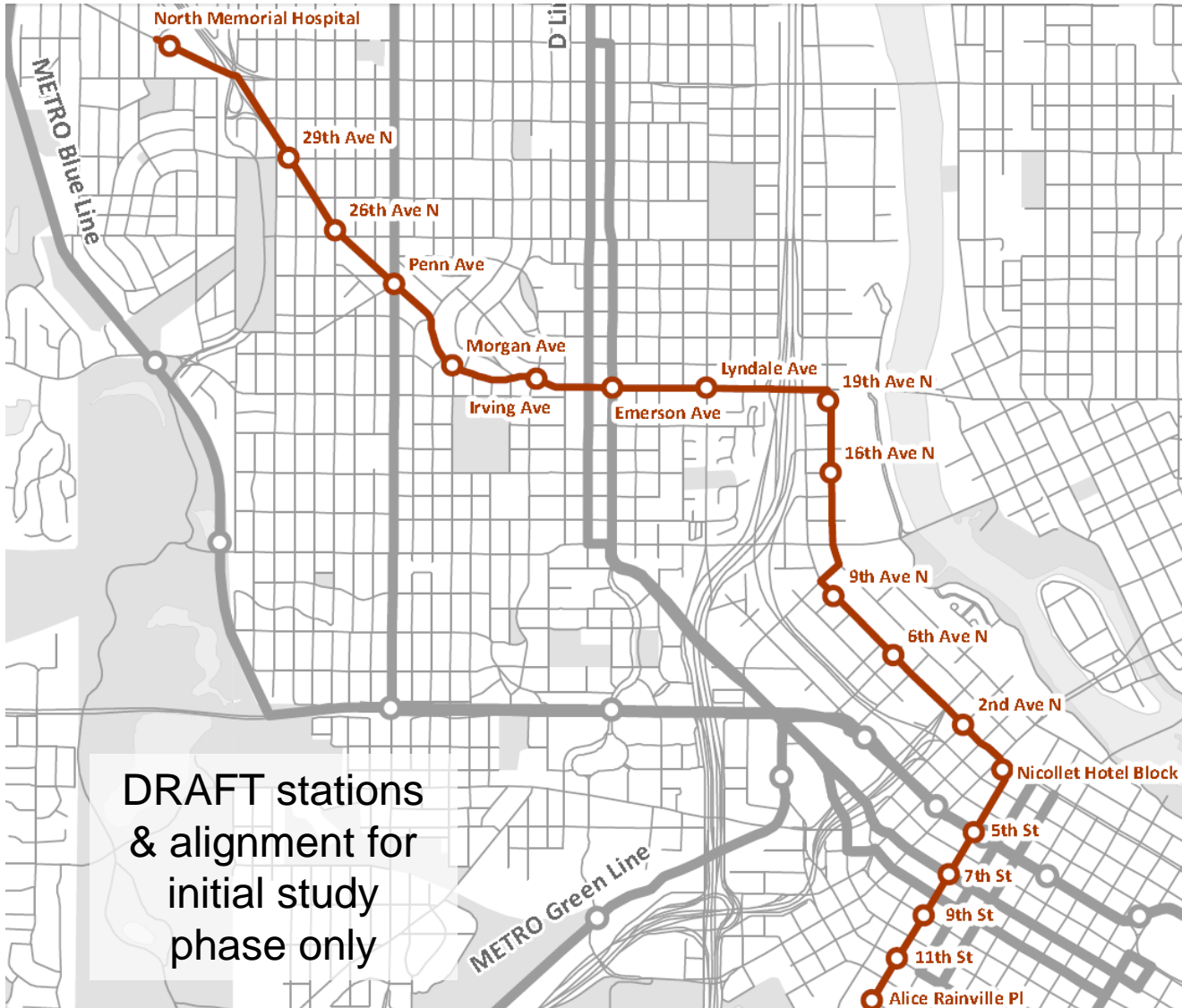
- Bus and Streetcar Improvements

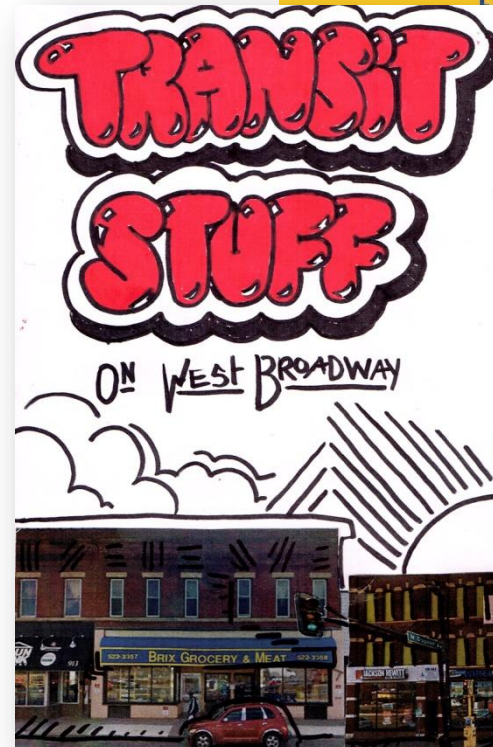

Get a chance to win a free-ride pass, see the Metro Transit fleet, hear transit stories and learn about the transit study.

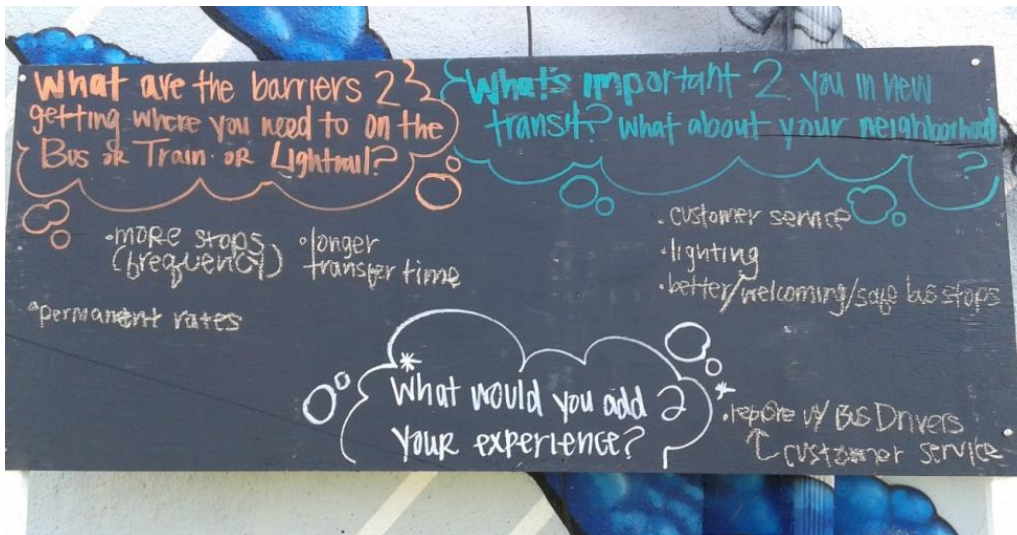
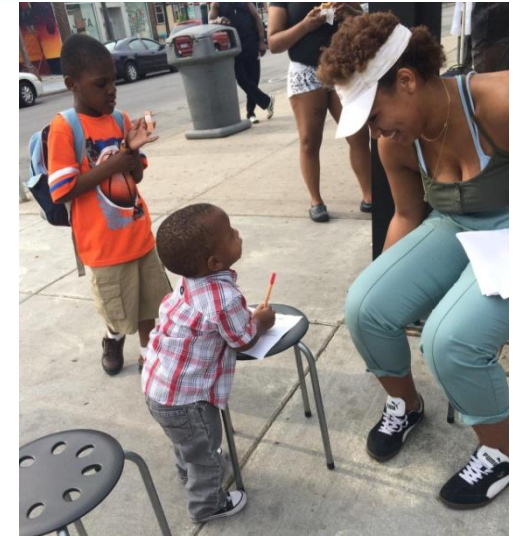
