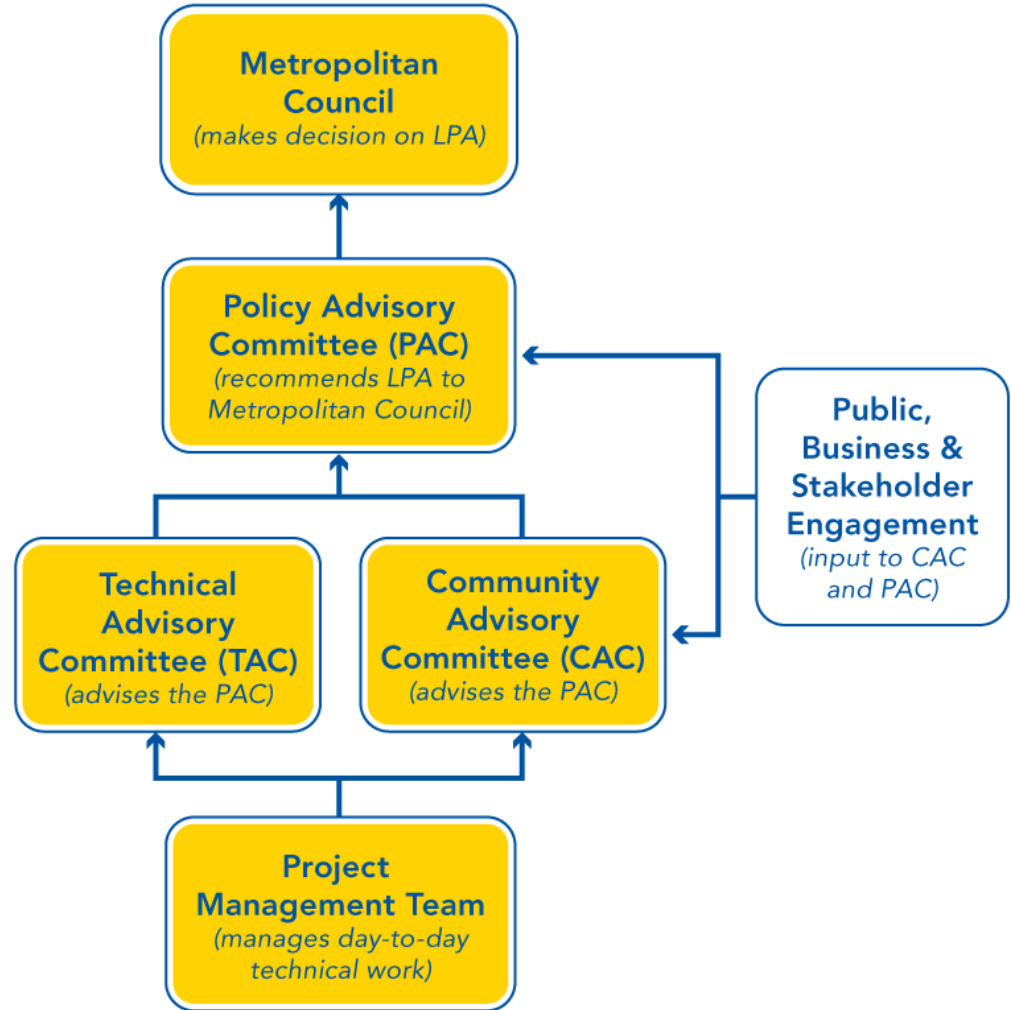

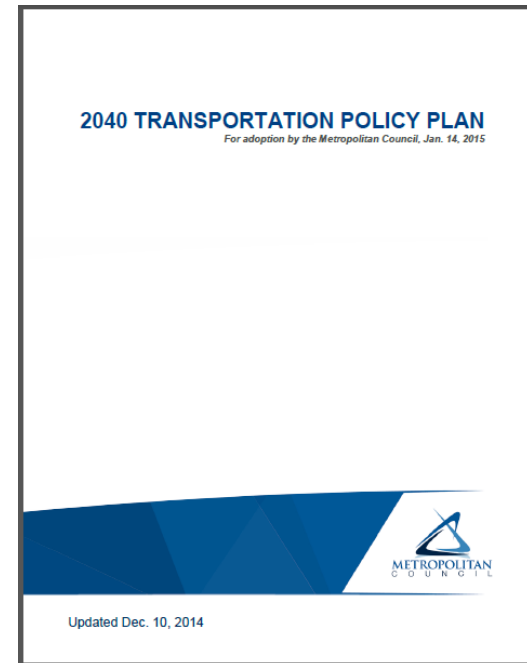

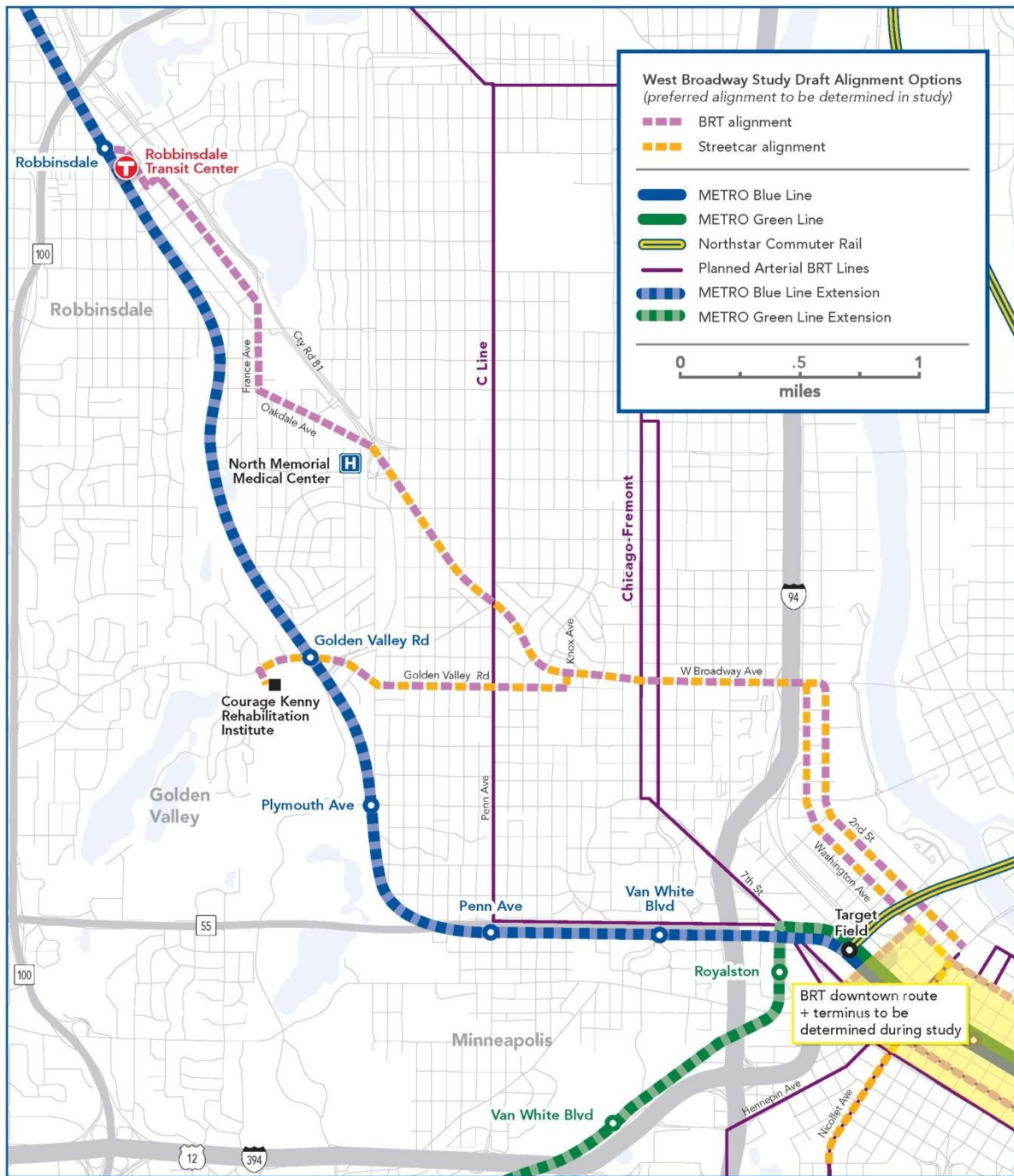


## What is the intended outcome of the Study?

- The Study will result in the recommendation of a **locally preferred alternative (LPA)** that **best meets the identified purpose and need** for the West Broadway corridor in December 2015



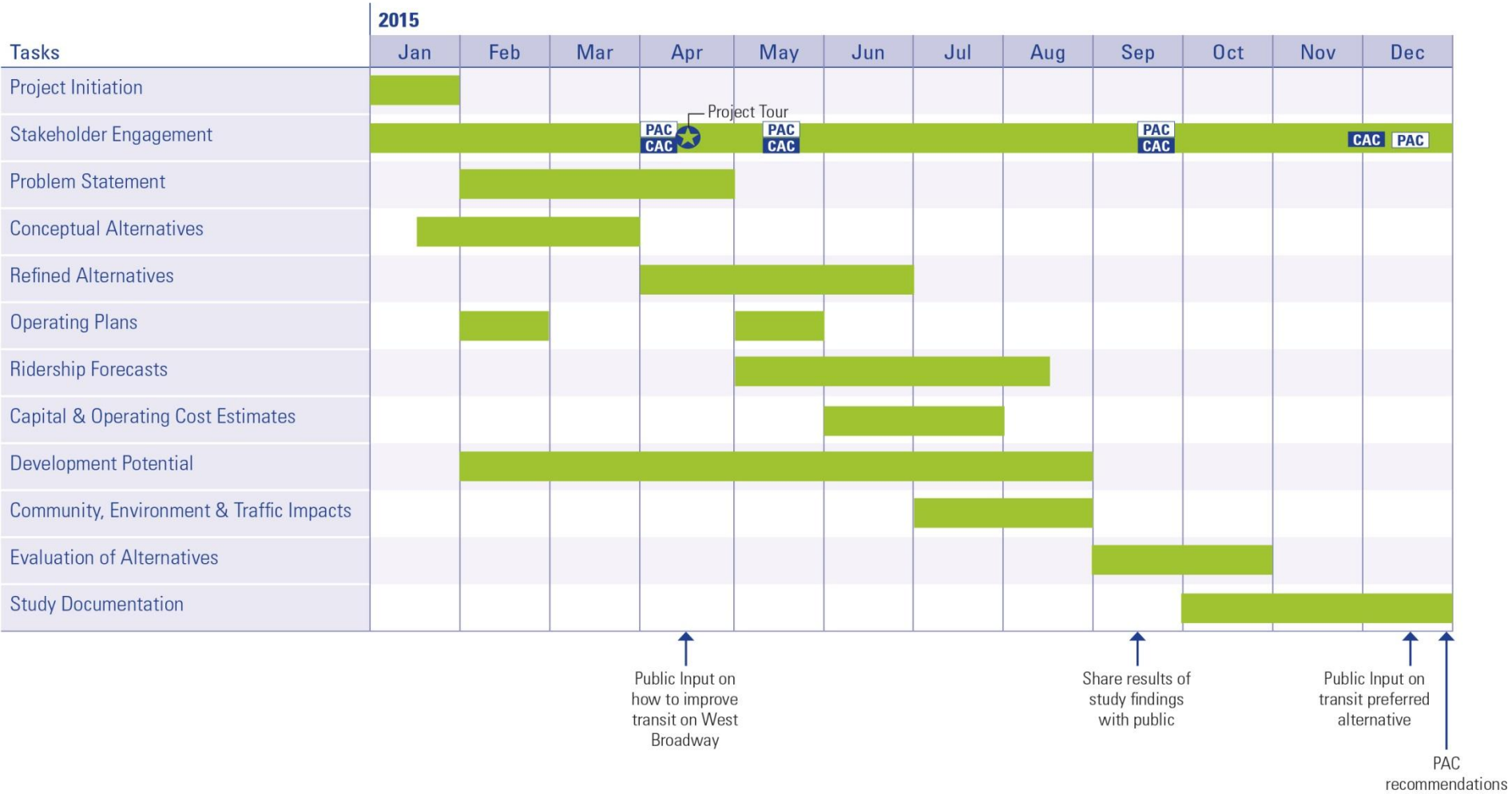




# Study Area Map

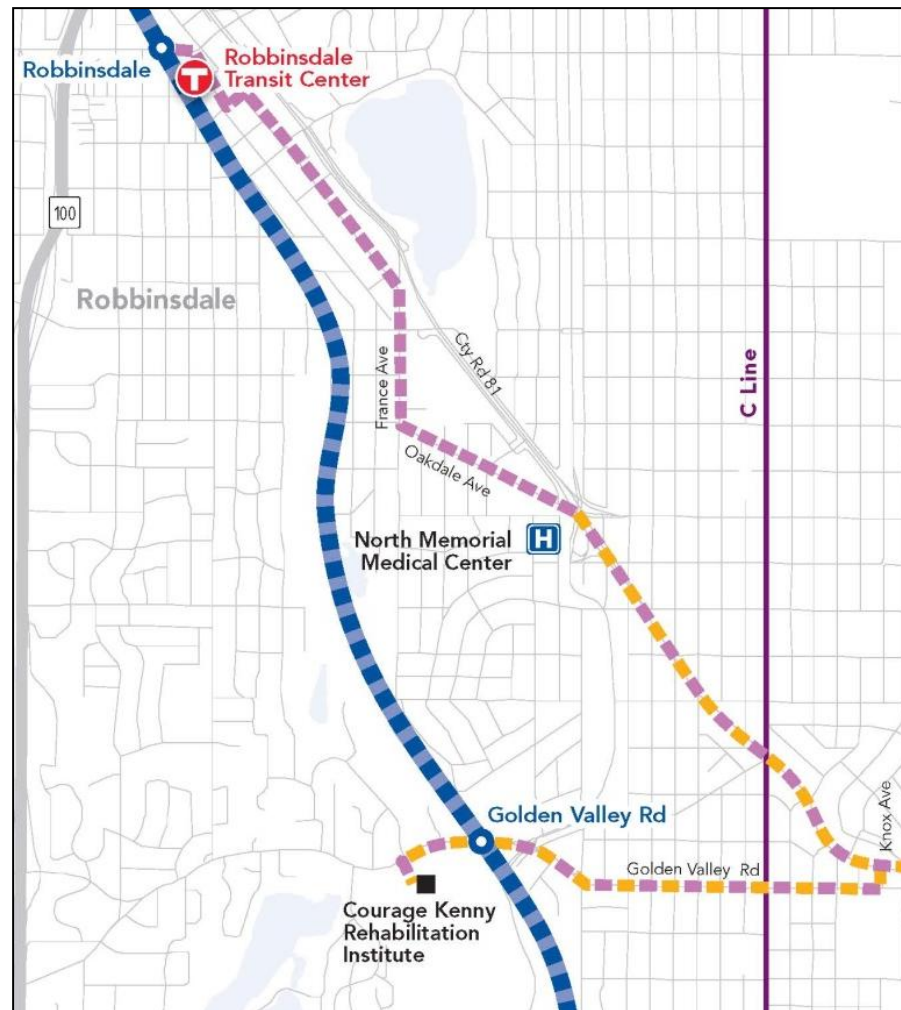

Arterial BRT from downtown to Courage Kenny	Under Consideration
Streetcar from Nicollet Mall to Courage Kenny via McNair	Under Consideration
