### What is a TIP?

- Four-year list of transportation projects funded in whole or part with federal funding
- Must include all projects funded with federal transportation funds and projects that affect air quality prioritized by year
- Required for all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)



### **Key Criteria for TIP and Amendment Approvals**

- Consistent with expected funding level fiscally balanced TIP
- Consistent with regional transportation plan
- In conformity with Clean Air Act requirements
- Opportunity for public input




### Schedule for 2016-2019 TIP

- TAB approves draft for public review June 17, 2015
- Public review/comment period ends August 5, 2015
- TAB considers comments, approval August 19, 2015
- Transportation Committee concurrence
  – September 14, 2015
- Metropolitan Council concurrence September 23, 2015
- MnDOT inclusion into STIP September/October, 2015
- Federal approvals November 2015

## **Source of Funds 4-Year Summary**

- Federal Highway \$916 Million
- Federal Transit \$820 Million
- Property Tax and State Taxes \$1.1 Billion
- Trunk Highway \$586 Million
- Total \$3.4 Billion
