Thrive 2040 Outcomes: Sustainability

- Operating the region's wastewater treatment and transit systems sustainably
 - Increase energy efficiency.
 - Use of renewable energy sources.
 - Reduce greenhouse gas emissions from Council operations.
 - Conserve and protect water resources.
 - Reduce solid waste generation.
 - Reuse and recycle materials.







Project Overview

- Behind the Meter
 - 6 Metro Transit Rooftops (4.7MW)
 - Regional Maintenance Facility (300 kilowatts (kWh))
- Community Solar Gardens (CSG)
 - Subscriptions: 40% MCES and 40% Metro Transit
 - Empire Wastewater Treatment Plant (5 MW)
 - Seneca Closed Landfill Site at Plant (955 kWh)
 - Woodbury Lift Station (679 kWh)









Behind the Meter Solar Facilities

- Council pays developers for power produced through a Power Purchase Agreement
- Facility License Agreements to developer
- Systems connected directly to Transit facility
- Developer installs and operates the solar arrays
- No up front capital investment into solar arrays
- Pay back with energy purchase



Roof-mounted Solar sites








Behind the Meter RFP

- Joint procurement with ES/MT to purchase electricity at a locked rate for 25 years
- FTH, Nicollet, South, Mpls LRT O&M, OHB, EMTF
- Roof top solar arrays totaling 4.7 MW AC
 - 22,000 solar panels
- Generates 6.7 MWh annually
 - 50% of electrical consumption
- Useful life 40 years
- Estimated savings \$4,000,000 (25yr)
- Operational 2016








System located on-site




2016 Electrical Profile Metro Transit
