Levels of Worker Protection

- Incidental Access – 30 minutes or less where the employee is responsible for self-protection if not with a Designated Lookout.
- Restricted Speed Zone – In areas where trains have clear visibility of the area, the work does not hinder the ability of the work group to see or hear an approaching train, and the work group is clear prior to the arrival of the train.
