Project Overview

- Master Plan (2012-2013)

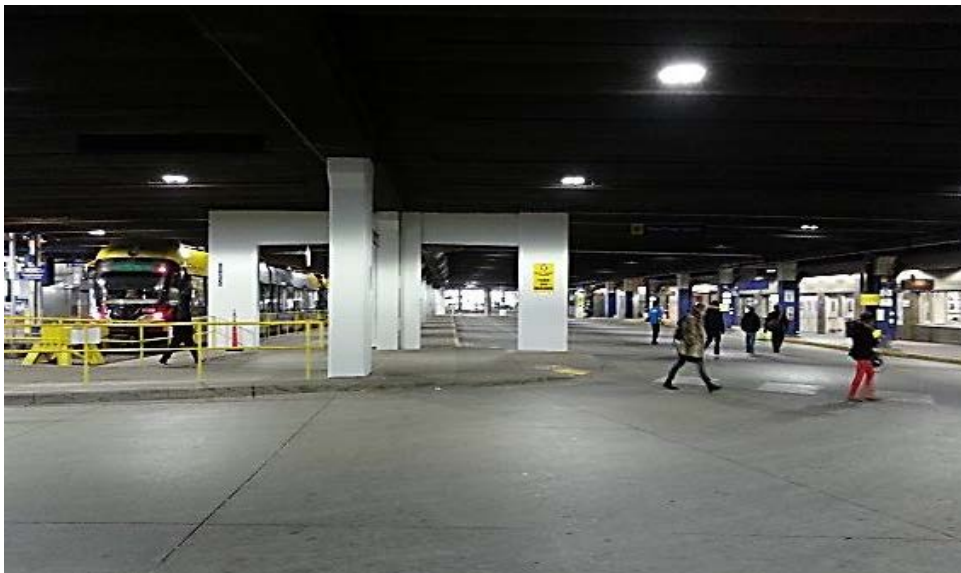


Transit Focused, Locally Prominent, & Regionally Significant

- Improves Bus Operations
 - Reduces Operating Costs by approximately \$1.3 Million annually
 - Improves Passenger Convenience
 - Expands Service Capacity
- Metro Transit's Busiest Transit Station
 - 2.65 million riders annually
 - Centered on 900 acres of Transit Oriented Development (TOD)
- Gateway to South Loop District
- Project Is Time Sensitive
 - 2018 - Super Bowl (Targeting Late 2017 Project Completion)
 - 2019 - Final Four
 - Possible Future Events – World Expo, BCS Championship

Overall Project Goals

- Improve efficiency of bus operations.
- Simplify access for mass transit vehicles.
- Provide clear and convenient pedestrian access.
- Improve station amenities, its aesthetic appeal, and visitor experience.
- Increase the exterior visibility and presence of the station.

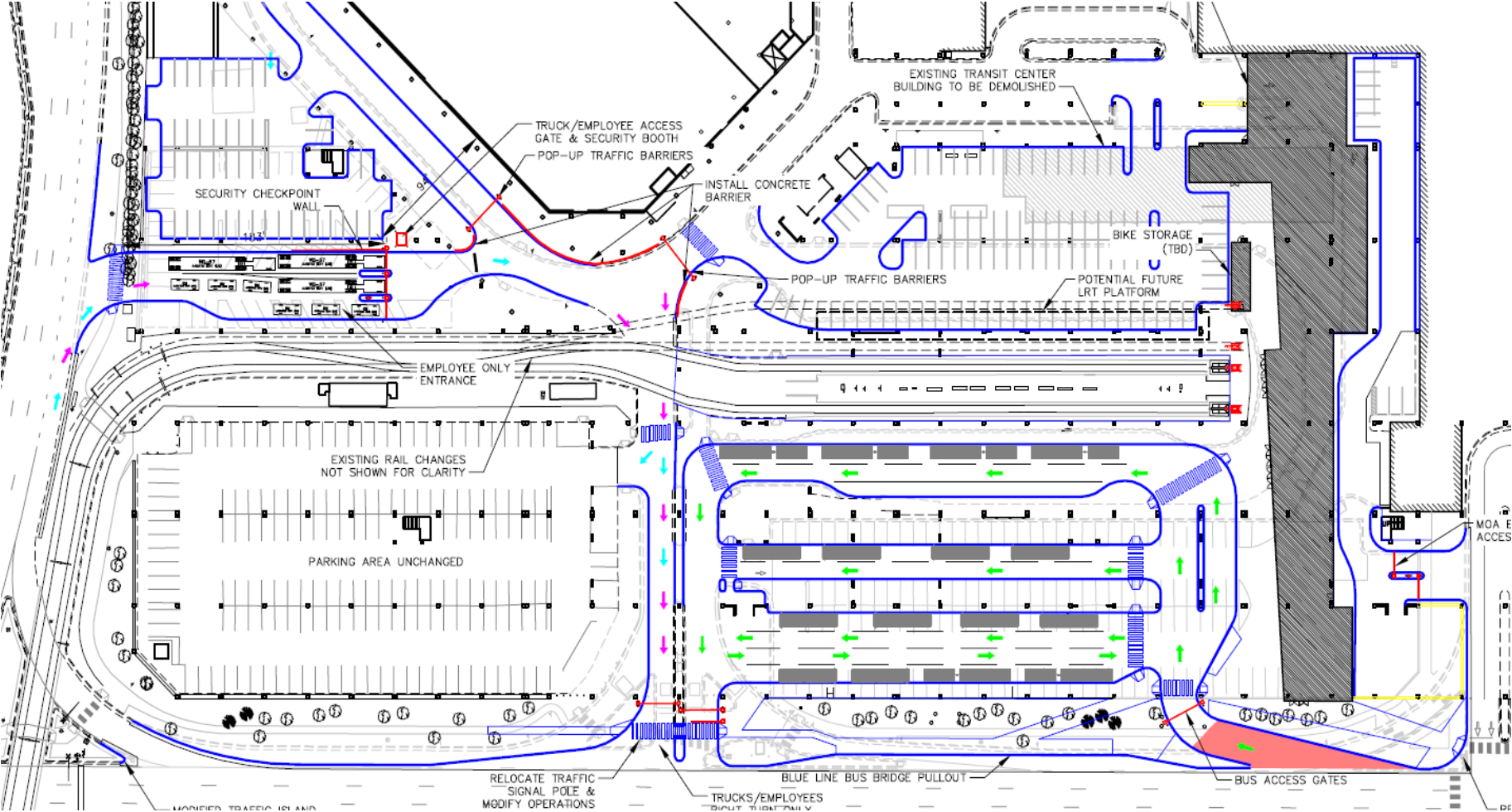

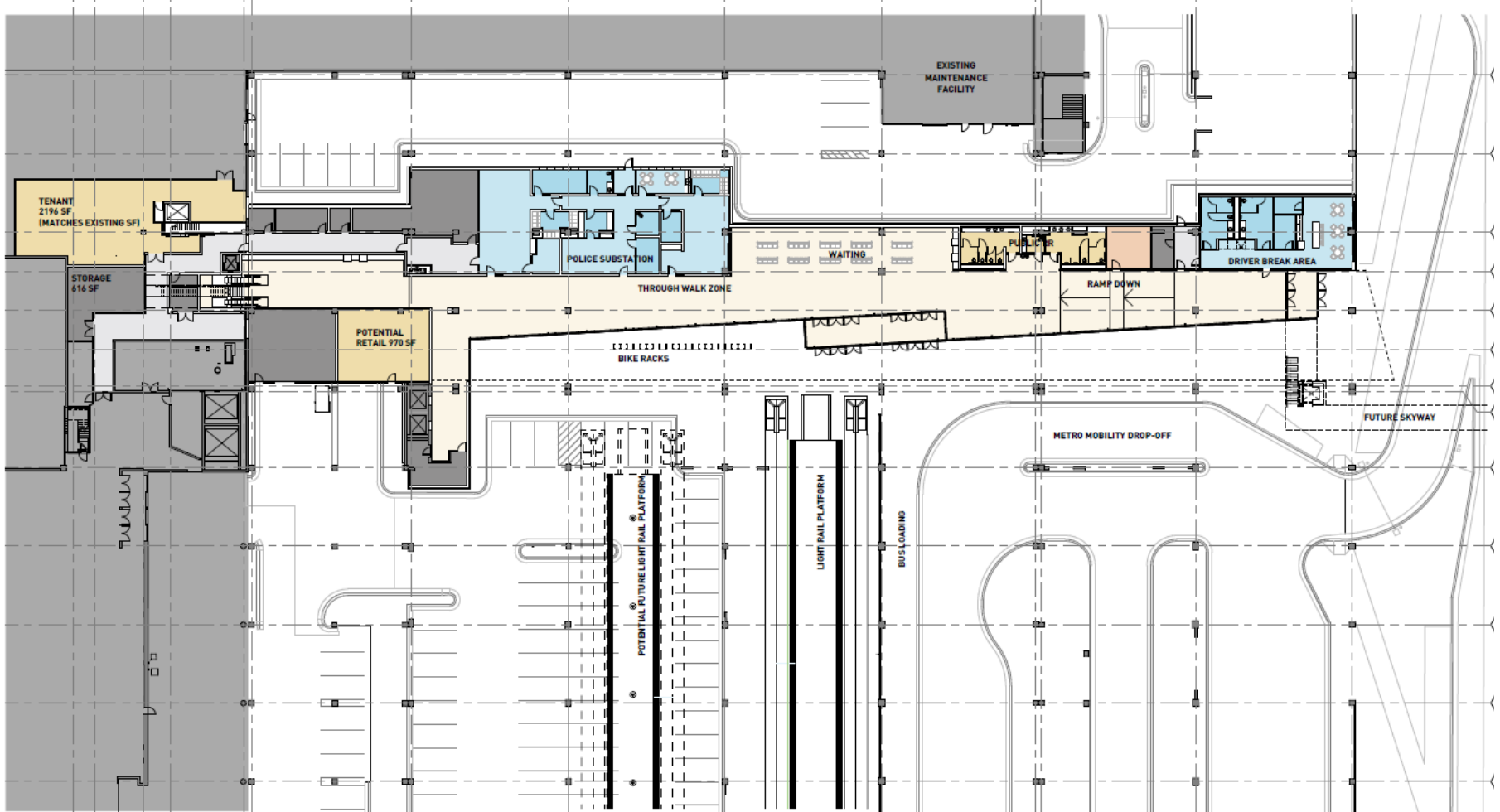

Architectural Layout





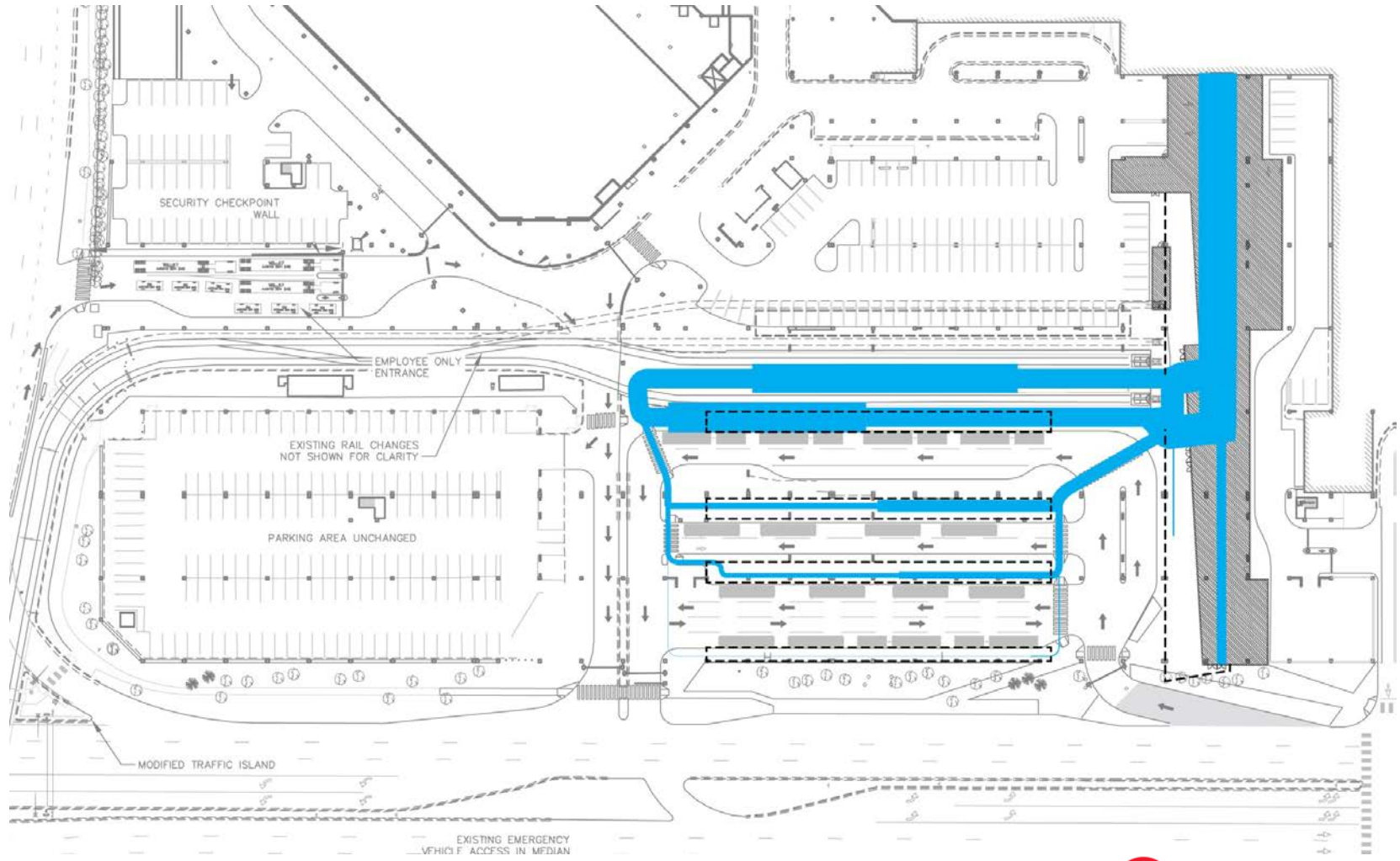






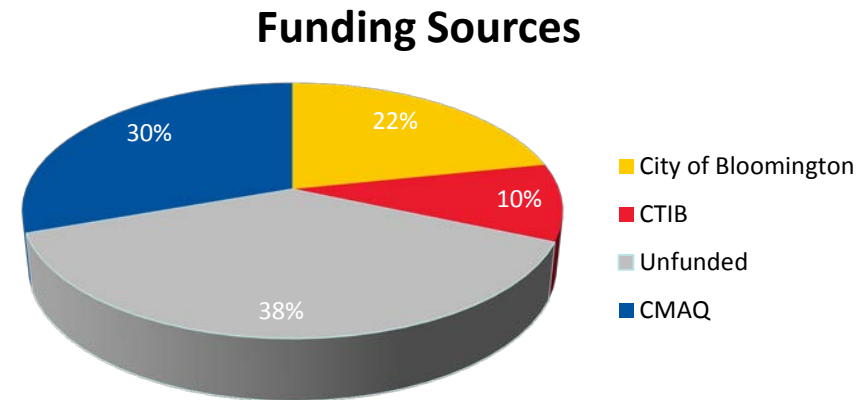


Pedestrian Flow

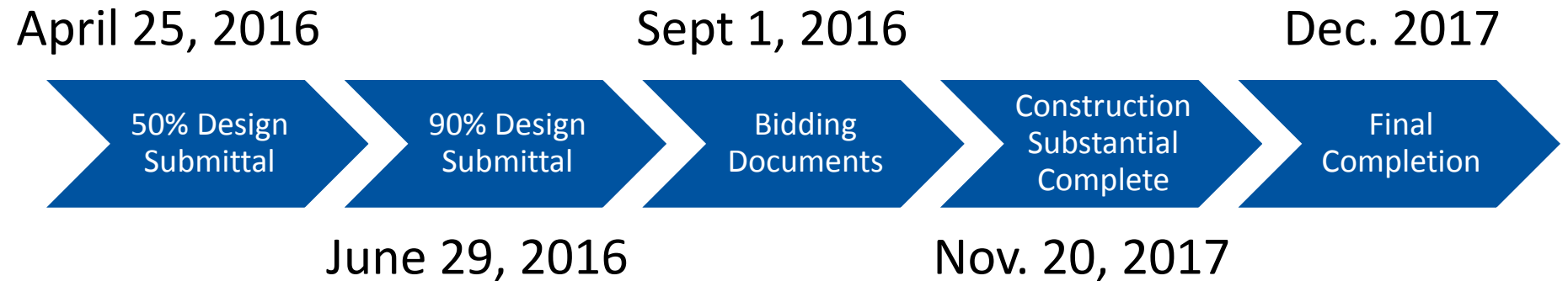


Capital Cost Estimate

- Estimated Project Budget: \$25 Million
- Current Funding: 16.25 Million
 - Metro Transit: \$2.0 Million
 - City of Bloomington: \$5.0 Million
 - CTIB: \$2.25 Million
 - CMAQ: \$7.0 Million
