

Transit Police HQ

- Police station containing up to 60,000 sq. ft. on four floors
 - MTPD headquarters
 - FTH Administration
- Home base for officers, who are deployed to multiple locations
 - Riding the bus
 - Riding the METRO lines or Northstar Commuter Rail
 - Squad car, bike, and foot patrol



Transit Police HQ Funding



- Estimated Capital Cost: \$27.5 M (2017 \$)
- Funds indentified in CIP: \$27.5M

Transit Police HQ Budget

- Design: \$2.5 M
- Management: \$0.5 M
- •Site Improvements: \$2 M
- Construction: \$22.5 M
- Total Budget: \$27.5 M







Heywood II Project Description

- 10 acre site in edge of North Loop just west of downtown Minneapolis
- 400,000 square foot bus maintenance and storage facility
- Storage space for 200+ buses
 - Approximately 20 maintenance bays
- 400+ living wage jobs
- 300+ construction jobs







Heywood II design input

- Internal kickoff and initial department interviews to revalidate 2011 program
- Sustainability charrette; focus on energy, resilience, happiness, beauty, health, water and land balance
- Site tours and input from users
- Design charrette with key focus on Transportation and Maintenance
- Next steps will be receiving input from operators and mechanics, neighborhood and City of Minneapolis


























Initial Concept Exterior











Heywood II Funding

- Estimated Capital Cost: \$106 M (2017 \$)
- Funds secured to date: \$16M (15%)
- 2016 State Funding Need: \$70.0M

Heywood II Budget

- Land Acquisition: \$11 M
- Design: \$7 M
- Management: \$4 M
- Construction: \$84 M

 Enhanced Energy Design Assistance Program
- MTPD Target Energy Use Intensity Goal below 30 kBtu/sf/yr with a goal of NetZero ready.
- Heywood II Target Energy Use Intensity Goal below 50 kBtu/sf/yr
- Both projects are planning for future rooftop solar array.
