Metro Transit Light Rail Technician 2017 Approach

- Proven success from 2015 Bus Mechanic Technician cohort
- 66 Rail Technicians needed by 2020
- Minnesota legislative 2017 fiscal year appropriations, grant to Twin Cities Rise, in collaboration with Metro Transit and Hennepin Technical College, for Metro Transit Technician program. Total program funding \$406,420





Program Goals and Outcomes

- Goal 1: Provide a clear and direct pathway for individuals with the interest, aptitude, and financial need toward a career as a Metro Transit Rail Technician
- Goal 2: Build a talented and diverse Rail Technician workforce; Signal Technicians & Electro Mechanic Technicians
- Goal 3: Place and sponsor10 to 20 program participants into Hennepin Technical Colleges 2 year degreed program in Fall 2017
- **Goal 4:** Present offer of employment to all the graduates Summer of 2019






