




- Sec. 85. [DAN PATCH COMMUTER RAIL LINE; PROHIBITIONS.]
 - Subdivision 1. [DEFINITION.] For purposes of this section,
 "Dan Patch commuter rail line" means the commuter rail line
 between Northfield and Minneapolis identified in the
 metropolitan council's transit 2020 master plan as the Dan Patch
 line.
 - <u>Subd. 2.</u> [METROPOLITAN COUNCIL; PROHIBITIONS.] <u>The</u>
 metropolitan council must not take any action or spend any money
 for study, planning, preliminary engineering, final design, or
 construction for the Dan Patch commuter rail line. The council
 must remove all references, other than references for historical
 purposes, to the Dan Patch commuter rail line from any future
 revisions to the council's transportation development guide and
 the council's regional transit master plan.
 - Subd. 3. [COMMISSIONER OF TRANSPORTATION.] The commissioner of transportation must not expend any money for study, planning, preliminary engineering, final design, or construction for the Dan Patch commuter rail line. The commissioner must remove all references, other than references for historical purposes, to the Dan Patch commuter rail line from any future revisions to the state transportation plan and the commissioner's commuter rail system plan.
 - <u>Subd. 4.</u> [REGIONAL RAIL AUTHORITIES.] <u>No regional rail</u> authority may expend any money for study, planning, preliminary engineering, final design, or construction for the Dan Patch commuter rail line.

Minnesota River crossing remain congested, even with all planned improvements.






Dan Patch River Crossing

Key Findings

- Twin Cities & Western
 Railroad, the owner of the
 Dan Patch Swing Bridge, is
 not opposed to the idea of
 reestablishing a motor
 vehicle deck on the bridge
- The existing Dan Patch Swing Bridge is operational and serves a few trains per year





Dan Patch River Crossing

Key Findings

- The Minnesota Statewide Rail Plan designated the Twin Cities/ Albert Lea passenger rail corridor, which would use the Dan Patch river crossing, as a Phase I priority corridor.
- The Dan Patch Line intersects with the Mankato/Twin Cities passenger rail corridor as identified in Statewide Rail Plan as a Phase I priority corridor.
- The Dan Patch Line intersects with the Southwest Light Rail Line.
- There is a broad support for a shared use path crossing at the Dan Patch location
