Applications Received

- 146 Qualifying Applications
 - Roadway Expansion: 21 (23 in Previous Solicitation)
 - Roadway Reconstruction/Modernization: 35 (21)
 - Roadway System Management: 4 (10)
 - Bridges: 8 (6)
 - Multiuse Trails and Bicycles: 39 (31)
 - Pedestrian Facilities: 7 (9)
 - Safe Routes to Schools: 3 (3)
 - Transit Enhancement: 10 (12)
 - Transit System Modernization: 13 (1)
 - Travel Demand Management: 6 (13)

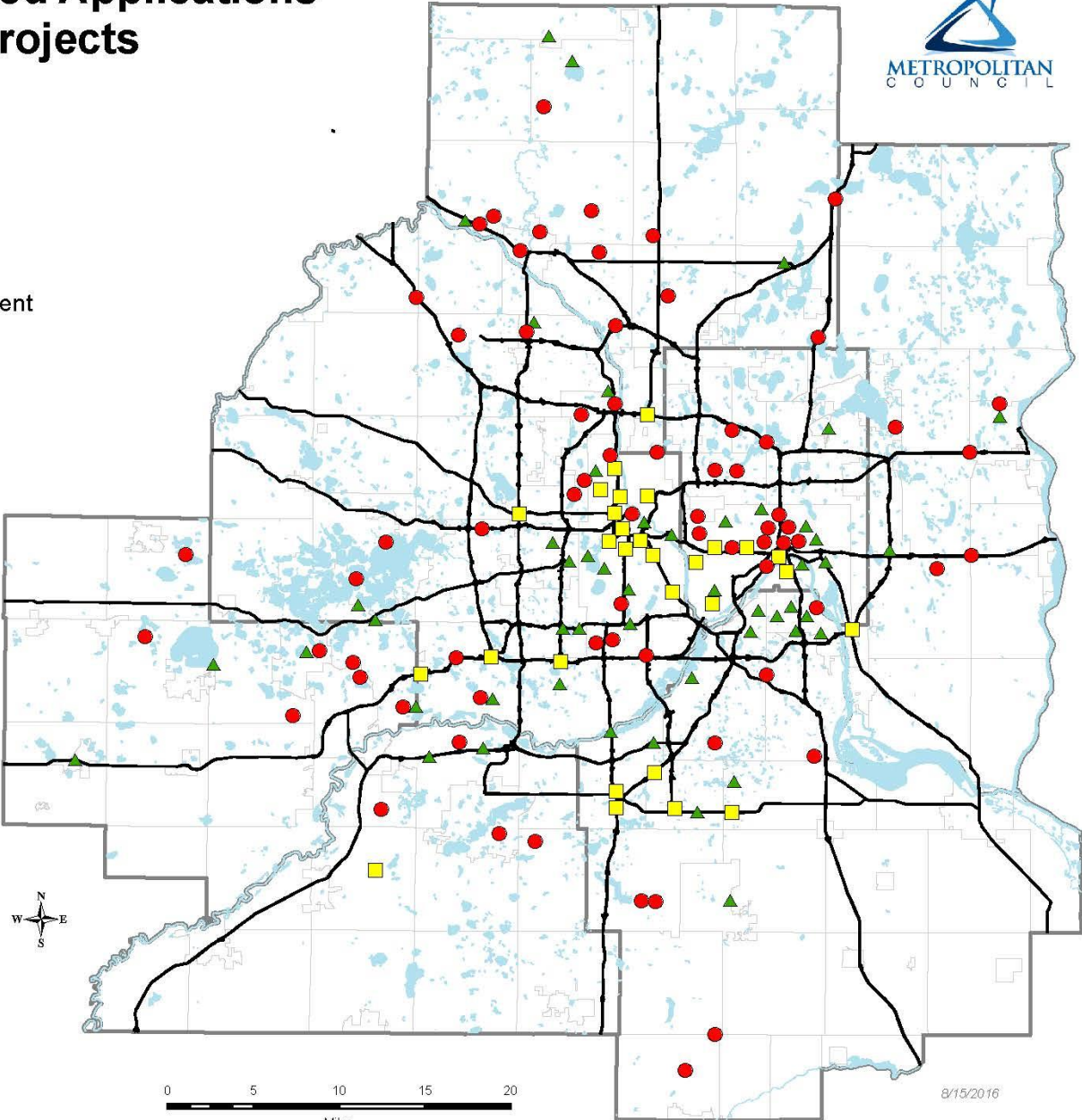


Modal Funding Category
