


Council Ridership – Q2 2017

Conclusions

Snelling Avenue corridor

- The dramatic increase in BRT ridership is due to the implementation of A Line in the Snelling Ave corridor.
- Much of the local route decrease is due to migration to BRT
- Overall ridership in the Snelling Ave. corridor (Route 84 and A Line) has increased significantly.
- Red Line BRT (Cedar Ave) ridership increased 2% over same time period in 2016
- Rail ridership is growing
 - Light rail ridership is up 6 percent
 - Northstar ridership is up 8 percent
- Metro Mobility slight increase
