


Estimated Fleet Tailpipe Particulate Emissions








Estimated Fleet Tailpipe NOx Emissions

Building Energy Use Intensity (kBtu/sq. ft.)







MMBtu/Ride & Annual Ridership








Gas Usage App

 - 3.2 MW Active CSG Subscriptions











Metro Transit Solar Participation

Be The Solution: Spring 2017 Campaign

- New waste sorting program
 - Centralized waste sorting stations for organics, mixed recycling, and trash
- New waste contract in 2017
 - Estimated savings: > \$50,000/year
 - Improved waste data collection and tracking
 - Expansion of new waste program to other facilities
- Future recycling initiatives for plastic film and pallets





waste sorting program








Heywood Office Waste Profile: Two months into
