

Project Overview

- New Limited Stop service for the East Side
 - 20 minute peak and 30 minute off peak service
 - Improved 10 minute peak service on West 7th Street
- Builds on strong Route 54 and 64 ridership and high transfer activity
- CMAQ grant funding for 3 years
- Service begins June 9th 2018


- Faster travel time-bus stop spacing, TSP, direct routing

- METRO Green Line, Blue Line, Red Line connections
- Ranked High in Service Improvement Plan












Route 54 Projected Weekday Ridership





Funding



Total Cost of \$7.2 million

- \$5.2 million for service improvement
- \$2 million for purchase of five buses

The project is funded by a mix of federal and local funds

- \$5.3 million in federal CMAQ grants
- \$1.9 million from Metro Transit's budget



Project Readiness and Schedule

- 2015: CMAQ funding secured
- 2016: Five new buses delivered
- Winter 2018: Schedules created
- Spring 2018: Arcade & Maryland Curb reconstruction
- Spring 2018: Marketing and public outreach
- Summer 2018: Service begins
