

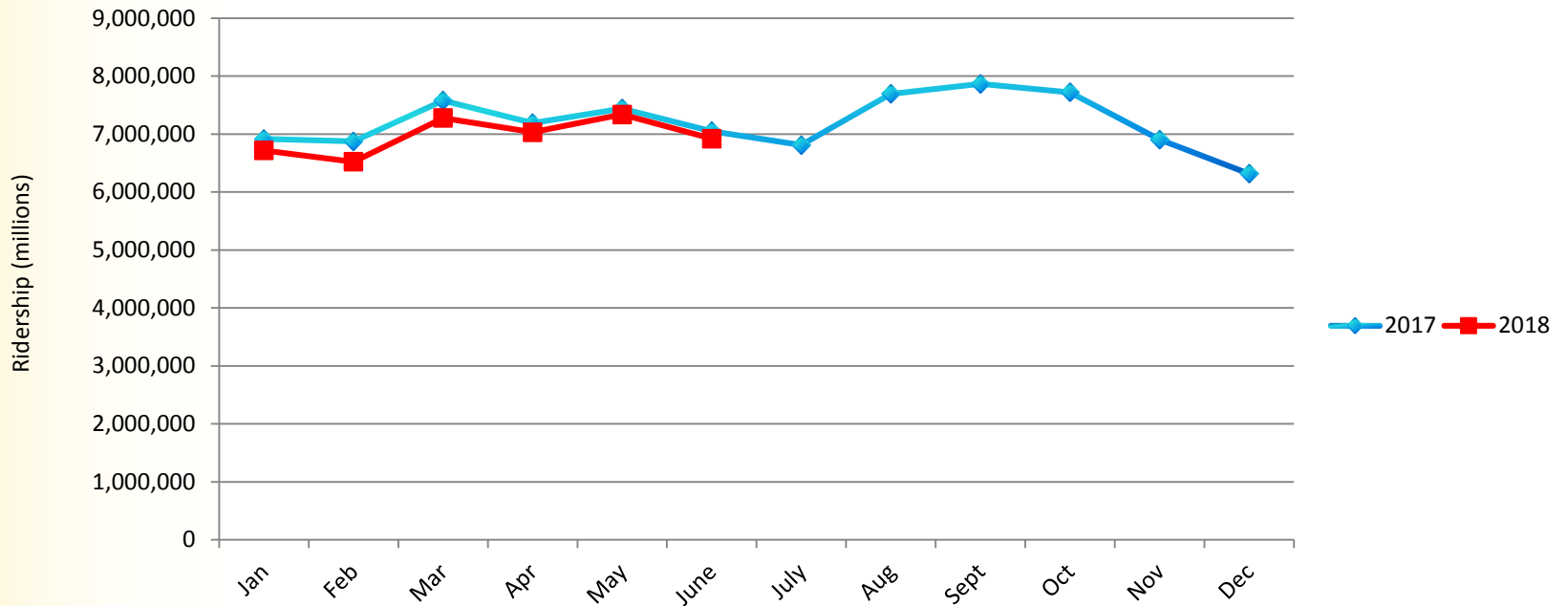

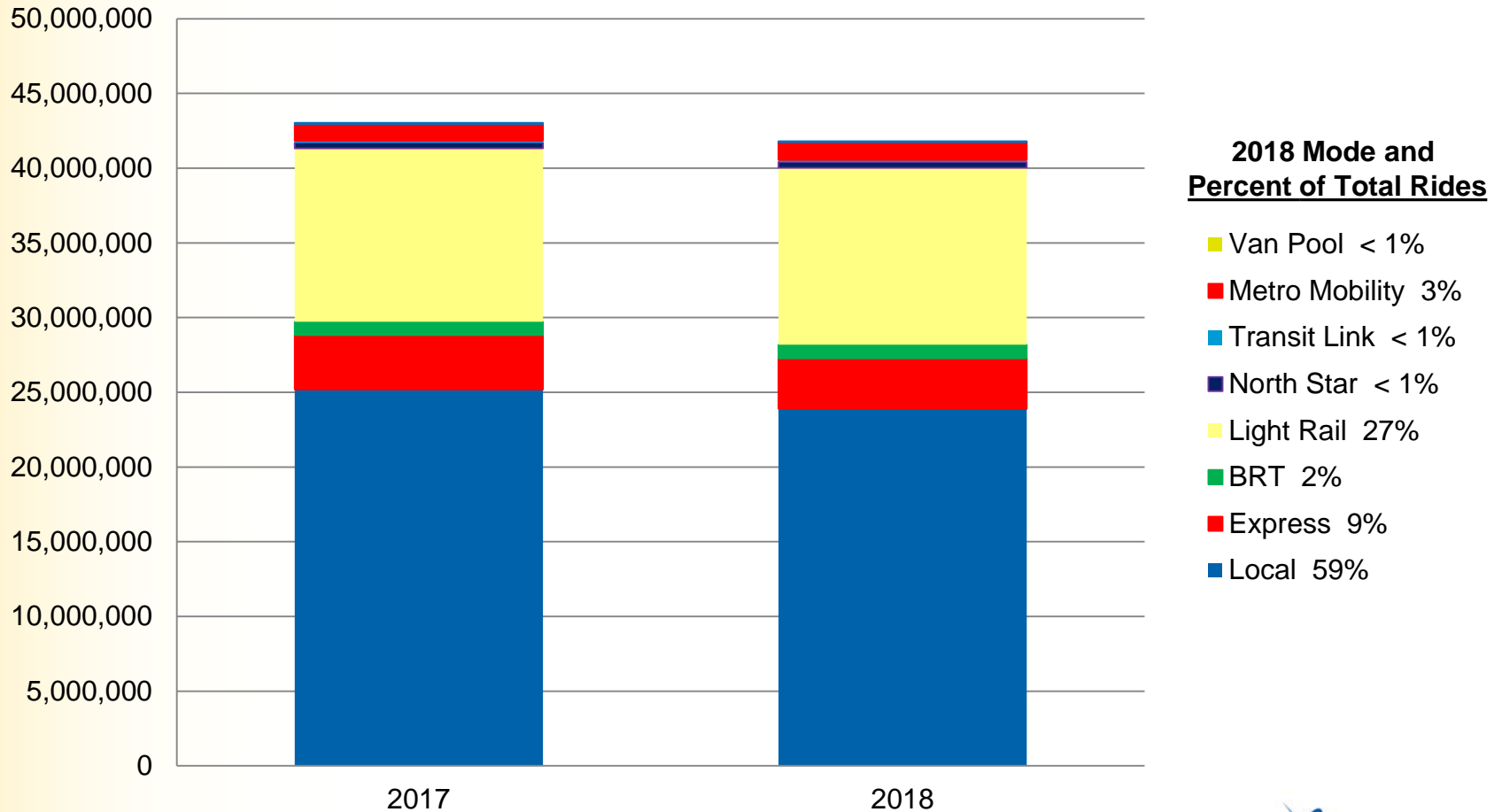
# Council Ridership – Q2 2018

# Conclusions

- Overall bus ridership is declining
  - Local bus ridership is down 5% and Express bus ridership is down 7% year to date. Primary drivers are industry trend and October 2017 fare increase.
- Transitway ridership is growing
  - Light rail ridership is up 2 percent
  - Northstar ridership is up 5 percent
  - BRT ridership is up 4 percent
- Other trends
  - Metro Mobility increased 6% from same time last year
  - Metro Vanpool decreased 13 vanpools from previous year
