





Interstate Highways State, US Highways and County Roads **County Boundaries City Boundaries** Lakes and Rivers Urbanized Area



# **Draft 2018 Funding Scenarios**

- **Base Scenario-Uses mid-point of funding ranges** 1.
- Expansion Heavy Scenario (both Roadways and 2. Transit)-Uses mid-point of funding ranges, but with more funding for expansion
- Modernization Heavy Scenario (both Roadways and 3. Transit)-Uses mid-point of funding ranges, but with more funding for modernization
- Bike/Pedestrian Heavy Scenario-Funds this mode at 4. a higher % by shifting \$ from other modes

### **Other Notes**

- The City of Saint Paul submitted a "unique project" request for \$6.67 million for electric vehicle charging stations and carsharing vehicles
  - TAB plans to take official action in January
- A major topic of discussion is the regional balance of the funding scenarios
- Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) recommendations from December meeting:
  - Create a 5<sup>th</sup> funding scenario that provides additional funding for roadway projects
  - Increase the program flexibility level from 8% to 10%

- January 16: Transportation Advisory Board (TAB): **Approval of projects**
- January 28: Transportation Committee Information Item
