




#### Council Ridership – Q1-Q2 2019 YTD 2018: 41,792,176 I YTD 2019: 40,262,551 (- 3.7%)

## **Observations**

- Local Bus and BRT ridership changes
  - Challenges: Bad weather days, downtown Mpls construction, fewer transfers
  - Opportunities: METRO C Line opened June 8
- Express Bus
  - Challenges: Bad weather days
- Rail modes
  - Opportunities: Light rail ridership continues notable growth, NCAA
    Final Four had positive impact



# **Observations**

#### Metro Mobility

- Average annual growth of approximately six percent over the past five years
- Bad weather days limited increase
- Transit Link
  - Reductions occurring primarily in Hennepin and Washington counties
- Metro Vanpool
  - Fifty-five active vanpools
