

Hennepin Bus Lane Pilot



- Three-day test in mid-May
- Data collection, public feedback, operations
- Very supportive public response
- Not proceeding with Hennepin bus lanes at this time
- Exploring other corridors for improvements
- City's American Cities Climate Change grant for additional bus lane pilots






Route 2: Improvement Strategies

- Stop consolidation up to ¼ mile spacing
- Transit signal priority
 - Limited by budget
 - Intersections prioritized based on analysis of delay
- Shelters





Route 2: Initial Results and Next Steps

- Initial results
 - 3% travel time reduction from routing change
 - 6% travel time reduction from stop consolidation
 - 1,200 more boardings at sheltered stops 88% of total
- Next steps
 - Further schedule refinements
 for March 2019
 - Continue planning for TSP





Measuring Performance

- Traditional metrics
 - Segment speed, on-time performance, dwell time
- Advanced metrics
 - Stop spacing
 - Detailed speed
 - Signal delay
 - Passenger delay









Future Projects

- Route-level comprehensive route review
 - Route 2
 - Route 63
 - Next... Route 4? Route 17? Possible output from Rapid Bus study update.
- Corridor-level TSP, stop spacing, bus lanes
 - Hennepin Ave
 - Nicollet Mall
 - New limited-stop service to Maplewood Mall (possible TSP)




Route 63

- Route description
 - Grand Ave downtown 3rd St East
 - METRO Green Line, colleges, Sun Ray Transit Center
 - 4,500 weekday boardings, 20" frequency
- Project overview
 - Similar to Route 2
 - Partner with St. Paul
 - Federal funding for service
 - March 2020 implementation





Nicollet Mall Working Group



- Improve bus speeds
 - Not FAST, but faster
- Average speed of 5.2 mph in PM peak
- Over 10,000 weekday boardings
- Explore signal timing and strategies to speed boarding
- Partnering with City of Minneapolis





Looking Ahead to 2019

- Next Steps
 - Continue to refine data tools
 - Grow partnerships with city staff
 - Build on lessons-learned from 2018 projects
- Timelines
 - Route 63: spring and early fall public outreach; March
 2020 implementation
 - Nicollet Mall
