- July 25 State Mask Mandate Begins
- Extensive Education Campaign in Place
 - Destination Signs
 - Stickers on all buses and trains
 - metrotransit.org
 - Social media
 - MTPD and Staff outreach



Why Enhanced Mask Enforcement

- COVID Cases Rising
- Safety Fatigue
- Current Compliance Rates on Transit too Low
 - 83% on bus
 - 69% on LRT
- Goal = 95%


Staff Helps With Mask Distribution

Four Step MTPD Enforcement Approach






MTPD-Outreach and Observation

- Data Collection






MTPD-Mask Enforcement Data: Patrol





MTPD – Mask Enforcement Data: RTIC




