

Project Goals

- Link residents, jobs, services
- Retain existing riders and grow ridership
- Prioritize service for those who rely on transit the most
- Simplify route network, enhance mobility




January-February 2021 Public Input Process

- Outreach strategies
 - Website, survey, video presentation
 - Social, ethnic and local media
 - Virtual community meetings/public hearing
 - Postcard mailer, in-person outreach at key stops, partnered with stakeholders
- Received nearly 600 comments
- Overall support
 - Orange Line
 - Coverage of local branches on Route 535
 - Restoration of Routes 537, 542
 - Simplification of Routes 515, 539, 540, 542
 - Frequency improvements on seven routes
- Primary areas of concern
 - Route 515B, E branches
 - 90th St between Penn and France
 - Route 597 replaced by Orange Line and local transfer
 - Need to transfer to travel between Old Shakopee Rd east and west of 35W, Valley West shopping center



Modifications from Concept Plan


- New Route 7 branch to VA Medical Center in rush hours retains 66th St link
- New Route 501 between MOA and main entrance to FedEx, UPS on Cargo Rd
 METRO Orange Line Connecting Bus Study Recommended Plan April 2021
- Route 515 will serve affordable housing near 77th St/12th Ave
- New Route 534 extends west of I-35W (Penn Ave, 90th St, Normandale College)

Modifications from Concept Plan

- Restore Route 537 (August pick)
- Restore Route 542
 - Extend to Braemar Arena, keep 84th St jog, connect with SW Prime ondemand service
 - Add off-peak service on weekdays
- New Route 546 (replace proposed Route 536)
 - 98th St Station, Old Shakopee Rd, France Ave and 98th St to Normandale College, Village
 - Relocate transfer to 98th St Station


Highlights

- Frequent Orange Line service seven days a week
- 20% increase in service hours (plus Orange Line)
- All I-35W South express buses resume stop at Lake St
- Improved frequency on seven routes
- All Route 7 trips will serve Cedar Point Commons
- Route 515 returns to High Frequency Network
- All Route 535/597 local branches have replacement service
- Fast connection between Orange Line and Normandale College via 98th St on Route 539
- West Bloomington coverage service on 84th, 90th streets and Poplar Bridge, Collegeview roads



Maintain High Access to Urban Destinations

- There is already a high level of service in many places where many BIPOC and/or people with lower-incomes reside
 - Existing routes provide good connectivity with Orange Line stations
 - Core local routes are operating at pre-pandemic levels
 - Nearly 100% of the residents have access to service
 - 70% of the area have access to high-frequency service
- Recommended Plan mostly maintains or improves existing service levels in these areas





Improved Access to Suburban Destinations

- 10,000 students enrolled at Normandale Community College (40% BIPOC)
- 55,000 jobs in the I-494 corridor between Mall of America and Hwy 169 (20% BIPOC)
- SW Bloomington Industrial Park: 4,500 jobs (15% BIPOC)
- Golden Triangle: 18,000 jobs (15% BIPOC)










Communications


- Primary goal is to inform
