REVENUE SCENARIO DEFINITIONS

Current revenue scenario

 Revenues that the region can reasonably expect to be available through 2040, based on experience and current laws and allocation formulas, including inflationary growth.

Increased revenue scenario

 Revenues that the region might reasonably attain through policy change, laws, or decisions that increase funding for a set of prioritized projects and programs.



Arterial bus rapid transit

Current revenue scenario

- Extend the B Line to downtown
 Saint Paul
- Include the E Line from Saint Paul to Edina
- Add the F and G lines selected in 2021

Increased revenue scenario

- Adds or updates the H Line and seven remaining candidate corridors
- Removes three formerly recognized corridors



Freight projects

Current revenue scenario

- MnDOT Minnesota Highway
 Freight Program
 - Allocates \$20 to \$25 million/year
 - Adds six highway freight projects
 - \$47 million over multiple years

- 117th Ave Reconstruction and Modernization (City of Inver Grove Heights)
- I-35W/I-494 Interchange Improvements (City of Bloomington)
- Highway 212 Rural Freight Safety Project (Carver County)
- I-94 Eastbound Lane Improvement Project (MnDOT, Woodbury/Oakdale)
- Highway 10/169 Ramsey Gateway Project (City of Ramsey, Anoka County)
- Sherburne County 33 Reconstruction and Realignment (City of Elk River, Sherburne County)
