Overview of 2022–187 SW: University of Minnesota Universal Pass Agreement

- Council Action:
 - That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to: Enter into an agreement with the University of Minnesota for a Universal Pass Agreement for registered students at the University of Minnesota for the period of August 15, 2022 to August 14, 2026.

 In partnership with the University of Minnesota, Metro Transit developed a Universal Transit Pass program for all registered students at the University of Minnesota Twin Cities – approximately 39,000 students

Builds on U of M Partnership

- Metro Transit has partnered with the University of Minnesota Twin Cities to offer a transit program for students who opted to participate since 1999.
 - Number of students participating in U Pass in 2018-2019 (average of pre-COVID years): 10,000
 - Number of students participating in U Pass in Spring 2022: 6,000
 - U Pass Revenue in 2018-2019 school year (average of pre-COVID years): \$3.5M
- The student body has expressed interest in a program that would allow all registered students to obtain a pass for every student and paid through student fees.

Universal Transit Pass Overview

- Universal transit pass programs cover all eligible registered students; does not require them to opt-in
- U of M Twin Cities joins other colleges in our region with universal transit pass programs: Anoka Ramsey Community College, Anoka Technical College, Augsburg University, Normandale Community College, and Macalester
- Approximately 180% ridership increase at Augsburg and Macalester after their first year of participation

Key Contract Terms

- Year Contract: August 15, 2022 to August 14, 2026
- All U of M registered students Approximately 39,000
- Universal pass valid on all Regional Bus, Light Rail, Commuter Rail
- Will utilize current MiFare Chip to be installed on the existing U of M U-Card technology
- Pricing Year 1 and 2 at \$3.5M per year. Years 3 and 4 at minimum of \$3.5M and maximum of \$4.375M
- Transit Benefit: increases ridership and builds transit habits that could continue after they leave school

Maximum Contract Price Years 3 and 4 will be no more then 125% of the actual value of rides utilizing the U of M Universal pass from February 28, 2023 to February 27, 2024 at the 40% discount.

Maximum Contract Price utilizes ride utilization to set the future price.
