# **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council adopt an amendment to the 2022-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add an additional work location to, and increase the cost of, MnDOT's I-394 ramp intersection project.

## **Background**

MnDOT is adding a second work location to its I394 ramp intersection modification project. This includes a \$169,000 cost increase. This is a 2023 project being changed to match the draft 2023-2026 TIP.

#### Rationale

The Metropolitan Council approves formal amendments to the TIP. The project is consistent with the Transportation Policy Plan (TPP) and meets fiscal constraint because the federal, state, and local funds are sufficient to fully fund the project. The Minnesota Interagency Air Quality and Transportation Planning Committee determined that the project is exempt from air quality conformity analysis.
