



Planned Renovation Scope

- Vertical circulation & ADA access improvement
- Platform-level shelters, canopies, and passenger amenities
- Lighting, technology, systems
- Wayfinding, multi-modal connections and station area landscaping
- Staff facilities



Proposed Action

- 2025-155
 - To negotiate and execute contract 25P213 with Kimley-Horn for design and construction services support in an amount not to exceed \$3,299,839
- Small Business Inclusion
 - The Office of Equity and Equal Opportunity (OEEO) established a 12% DBE goal for the project. OEEO has determined that Kimley Horn has met the DBE requirements.



Anticipated Timeline

- Full Design under contract 25P213 to be completed in September 2026
- Construction, including support services under 25P213 (2027-2028)
