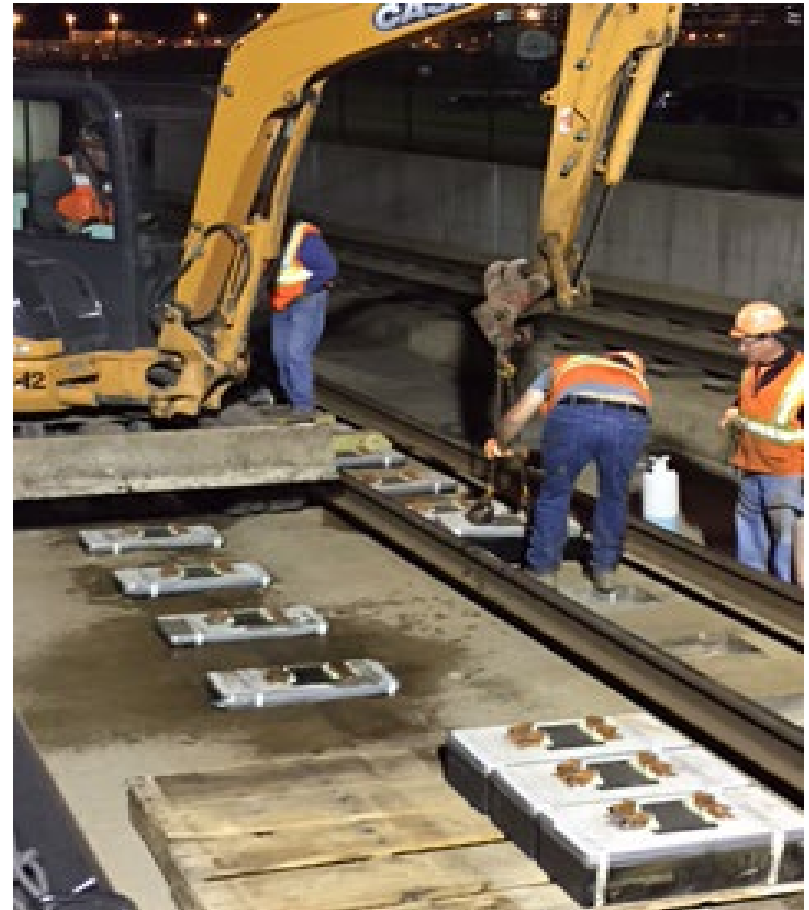

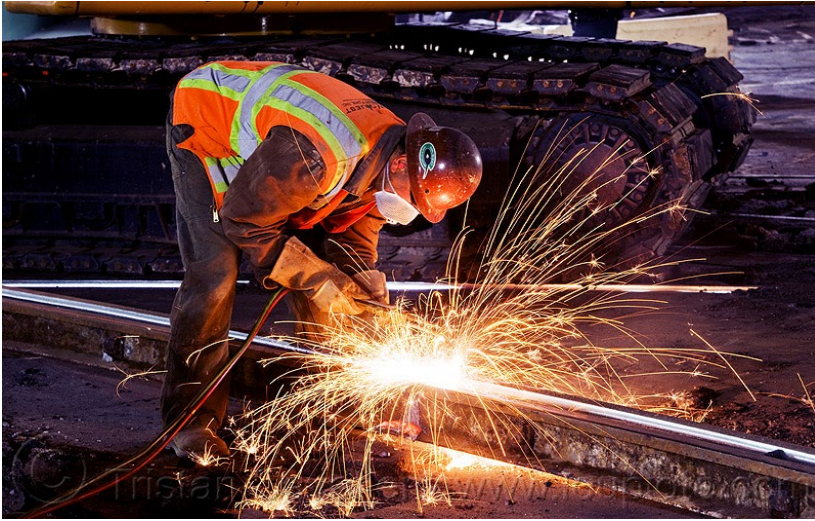
Metro Transit – Rail Systems Maintenance

Project Background

- Blue Line in service since 2004.
- Green Line in service since 2014.
- Increased Maintenance:
 - Rail Breaks/Service Failures
 - Profile and Alignment Deviations
 - Tie Replacement
 - Welding Services
 - Planned/Scheduled Maintenance Work Requirements



On-Call Track Maintenance Benefit



Purpose:

- Economic use of labor, material, and equipment
- Supplements Metro Transit's Workforce
- Ability to schedule planned work and emergency service response on shorter notice
- Fixed costs for contract duration

PROCUREMENT PROCESS

- An Invitation for Bid was advertised on April 28th, 2025
- Six Plan holders
- Pre-Bid Meeting held on May 9th, 2025
- Public Bid Opening held on May 29th, 2025
- One bid received from Railworks was \$627,746
- Railworks Track Systems, Inc., submitted the low responsive and responsible bid at \$627,746

Proposed Action: That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to award and execute a contract with Railworks Track Systems, Inc., to provide on-call and preventative track maintenance to the Blue and Green Lines in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 for a period of five years, through December 31, 2030.
