### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute a renewal contract 25P096 with Axon Enterprise Inc that will continue to provide body worn cameras for officers in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

#### **Background**

Metropolitan Council Policy 1-3-2, adopted on March 11, 2020, supports and demonstrates the clear intent for Metro Transit Police Department (MTPD) officers to wear body-worn cameras (BWCs).

MTPD is seeking approval to refresh MTPD's BWC's utilizing the State of Minnesota's cooperative purchasing venture Contract Release P-994(5). The Council has statutory authority under Minnesota Statute Section §471.345 to utilize such cooperative contracts.

#### Rationale

The execution of a goods and services contract exceeding \$500,000 requires Council approval.

#### **Thrive Lens Analysis**

The Council adopted Imagine 2050 on February 12, 2025, which builds on policy direction in Thrive MSP 2040. Under the Thrive lens, this action advances the outcomes of Leadership, Equity, Accountability and Stewardship by supporting safe and reliable transit infrastructure now and into the future for transit passengers throughout the region. It will provide tools that police officers can

use that will create transparency as well as aide in investigations.

# **Funding**

Funding for this procurement is included in MTPD's operating funds.
