Proposed 2023 Work Plan Goals

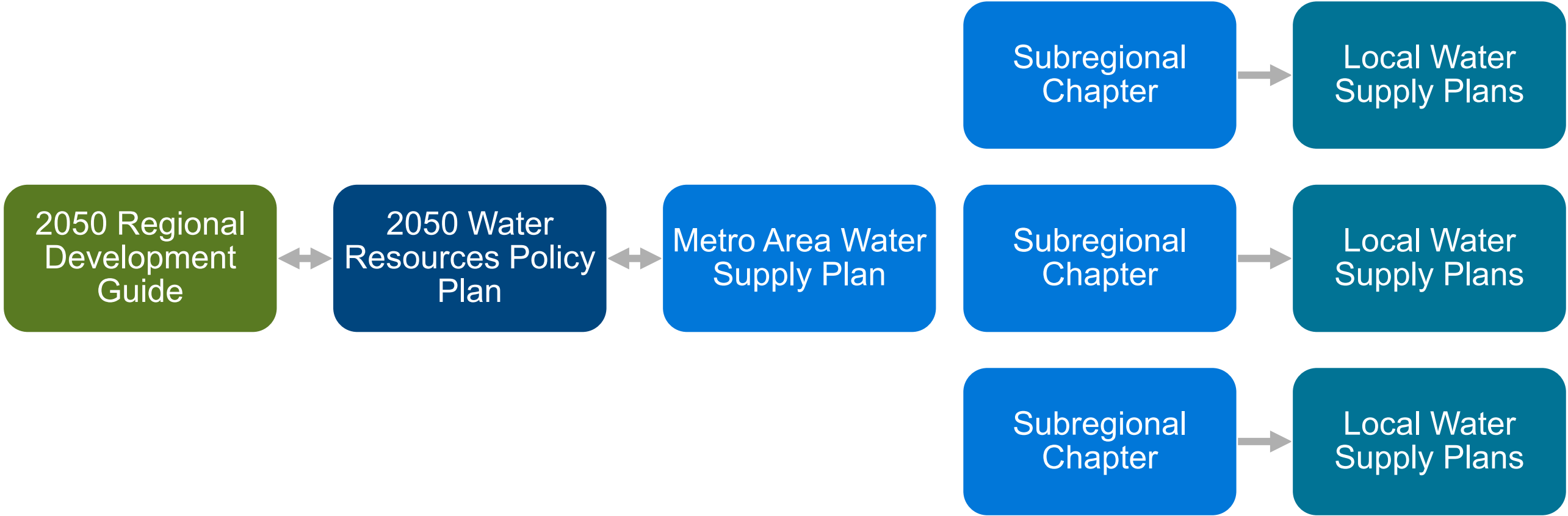
At the end of 2023, the committees will produce:

1. Summary document of how MAWSAC and TAC have influenced the Metropolitan Council's Regional Development Guide (RDG), Water Resources Policy Plan (WRPP), Metro Area Water Supply Plan (MWSP), and plans and projects.
2. Summary document about engaging subregional water supply work groups in 2023, to help local water supply plans better reflect subregional concerns and goals and to identify opportunities/projects that benefit multiple communities and advance regional vision.

Planning Framework in MWSP Chapter One



RDG sets the framework for our region, including land use policy and other cross-divisional issues

WRPP provides a framework for integrated water planning (wastewater, water supply, and surface water)

MWSP provides water supply-related considerations for developing regional, subregional, and local plans and supporting programs

MWSP also provides subregional context, shared objectives and strategies, and direction for implementation and partnerships

LWSP provides information and identifies local actions for a sustainable water supply

SPRING TAC in April MAWSAC in May	Begin regional policy exploration: Update on subregional approach, explore water issue white papers, share perspectives with Council regional planning project managers
SUMMER TAC in July MAWSAC in August	Continue regional policy exploration: Work on chapter two of metro area water supply plan (context and performance measures), continue to explore water issue white papers, updates on subregional work group project (ex: WHPP Pilot)
FALL TAC in October MAWSAC in November	Continue regional policy exploration: Continue work on chapter two of metro area water supply plan, continue to explore water issue white papers, share perspectives with Council regional planning project managers
WINTER Joint meeting of MAWSAC and TAC in January 2024	2023 evaluation and 2024 planning (joint meeting)
