Length of meeting	47% - 2 hours		2 members noted the travel time as being a significant factor for meeting length preference
Time of day	82% - afternoon		1 member is not available afternoons and 2 prefer mornings
Day of the week	65% - Wednesdays	35% - Tuesdays (2 members not available)	
Week of the month	78% - 1st or 2nd week		Split evenly between 1 st or 2 nd week; 1 member is not available the 3rd week
