2050 Transportation Policy Plan Policies & Actions Gap Review



### All Modes

- Advocate for increased and sustainable funding sources
- Expand funding eligibility to additional functional classifications
- Balance asset management with other needs
- Additional training, support, tools, and resources to advance regional priorities (equity, climate, accessibility, land use, etc.)

- Promote vehicle miles traveled reduction targets to address congestion and climate needs
- Incorporate equity and inclusive decision making
- Coordination across jurisdictions to expand multimodal networks
- Establish performance measures







# Roadway

- General disagreement on prioritizing preservation over other needs
  - Existing v. future needs
- Context sensitive needs
- Establish performance measures
- Expand mobility and accessibility to all modes to support highway operations
  - VMT reductions
  - Multimodal connections
- Need for stronger land use and transportation planning connections








# Freight

- Desire to expand freight considerations in the plan overall
- Comprehensive evaluation of all modes of freight movement
- Coordination with all levels of government
  - Land use and siting needs
  - Freight network development
- Coordination with private sector
  - Appropriate facility siting
  - Vehicle design
  - Truck parking

- Improved rail crossing safety
- Work to better estimate freight movements and address state identified bottlenecks
- Mitigate freight impacts on communities
- Focus on last-mile deliveries







### **Transit**

- Provide more suburban service and flexible options for service delivery
- Proactively address microtransit or demand-response transit
- Adjustments to transit performance measurement
- Coordinate roadway and intersection improvements with transit projects
- Security for riders and operators

- Support for administrative citations program
- Variety of fare system
  viewpoints, from more flexibility to
  more unity and seamlessness
- Interest in travel demand management tied to employers, in new development, and in the Regional Solicitation
- Identify local actions to increase density while avoiding displacement







## Bicycle and Pedestrian

- Improve network connectivity and broaden range of barrier removal
- Support better interagency coordination
- Local actions to improve mapping of bicycle and pedestrian networks
- Separate or create pedestrian-specific policies so they do not lose focus







## Safety

- Incorporate safety in all plan topics
- Strong support for Safe Systems approach to safety
  - Support safety plan developments
- Shift investments to respond to missed safety performance targets

- Mitigate climate impacts on infrastructure
  - Data and tools to identify high-risk areas
- Transit security needs and Regional Solicitation scoring
- Prioritize equity in safety investments







# **Equity**

- Prioritize equity or related topics and implement prioritization or performance measurement tools
- Variety of engagement practice comments, including:
  - Building standing and compensated relationships
  - o Translated and culturally-relevant engagement
- Focus on exposure to pollution and environmental justice
- Consider the workforce to create opportunity, both the transportation workforce and meeting employers' needs








### Environment

- Weave environment and climate action through all topics
- VMT, GHG, and emissions reduction targets
- Equity in environment and climate change
  - Address racial and economic disparities
  - Tools and resources to support project development
  - Anti-displacement strategies
  - Engagement

- Electrification and EVs
  - Not sufficient to meet climate change goals
  - No identified funding
- Promote additional natural elements through Regional Solicitation scoring
  - Green stormwater infrastructure
  - Habitats and natural landscapes







## Drafting policies and actions


#### **Policy Development Teams**

- Small teams with technical expertise
- Draft and recommend policies and implementing actions
- Present to TWG for discussion and refinement
- 3 to 5 meetings with independent work between meetings

#### **Hands-on Workshops**

- Policy Development Teams present draft policies and actions
- Series of half-day workshops with TWG to refine policies and implementing actions
- Staff facilitates activities and discussion
