## **Chapter 18 PROJECT BASED VOUCHERS (PBV) UNDER THE RENTAL ASSISTANCE DEMONSTRATION (RAD) PROGRAM**

The HRA is adding a chapter on Project based vouchers under the Rental Assistance Demonstration Program. While the HRA does not own any public housing, it may award project-based vouchers to housing authorities converting their public housing units through Rental Assistance Demonstration Program.
