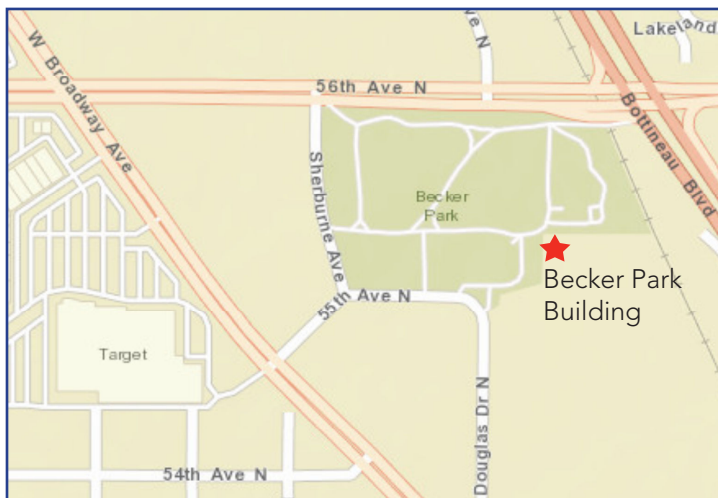

The planned Blue Line Extension Light Rail Transit Project, in partnership with the City of Crystal, is hosting an open house and meeting regarding visual screening along the BNSF freight rail corridor between Bass Lake Road and 62nd Avenue.

The Blue Line Extension Project Office (BPO) has received feedback from residents, Crystal City staff and City Council members regarding this issue. This meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to view a revised recommendation regarding a visual screening barrier and provide feedback.

This design will be shared with the Crystal City Council and subsequently incorporated into the project plans.

Conduct survey of property owners and gather data to create design

September 20, 2016

Provide update to Crystal City Council

October 17, 2016

Second public meeting to present design and receive feedback from property owners

November – December 2016

Finalize design and incorporate into project plans
