





- Red Line Extension (Cedar Avenue BRT)








Southwest LRT


- Connects communities of Minneapolis, St. Louis Park, Hopkins, Minnetonka and Eden Prairie
- Home to UnitedHealth Group, Optum, Cargill, Supervalu and Park Nicollet Methodist Hospital





Southwest LRT: Green Line Extension

- 34,000 average weekday rides in 2040
- Will provide single seat rides to downtown Minneapolis, U of M and St. Paul
- Connections to the Airport and Mall of America via the Blue Line









TRAIN YARD CONCEPT - SITE PLAN - Work In Progress









- Recipients that receive \$250,000 federal funding or more a year




To Be a DBE in Minnesota:


