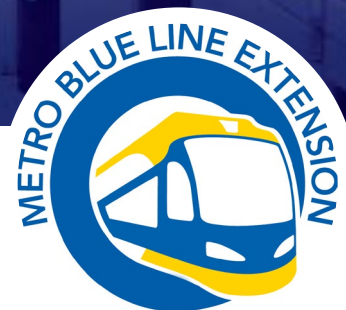

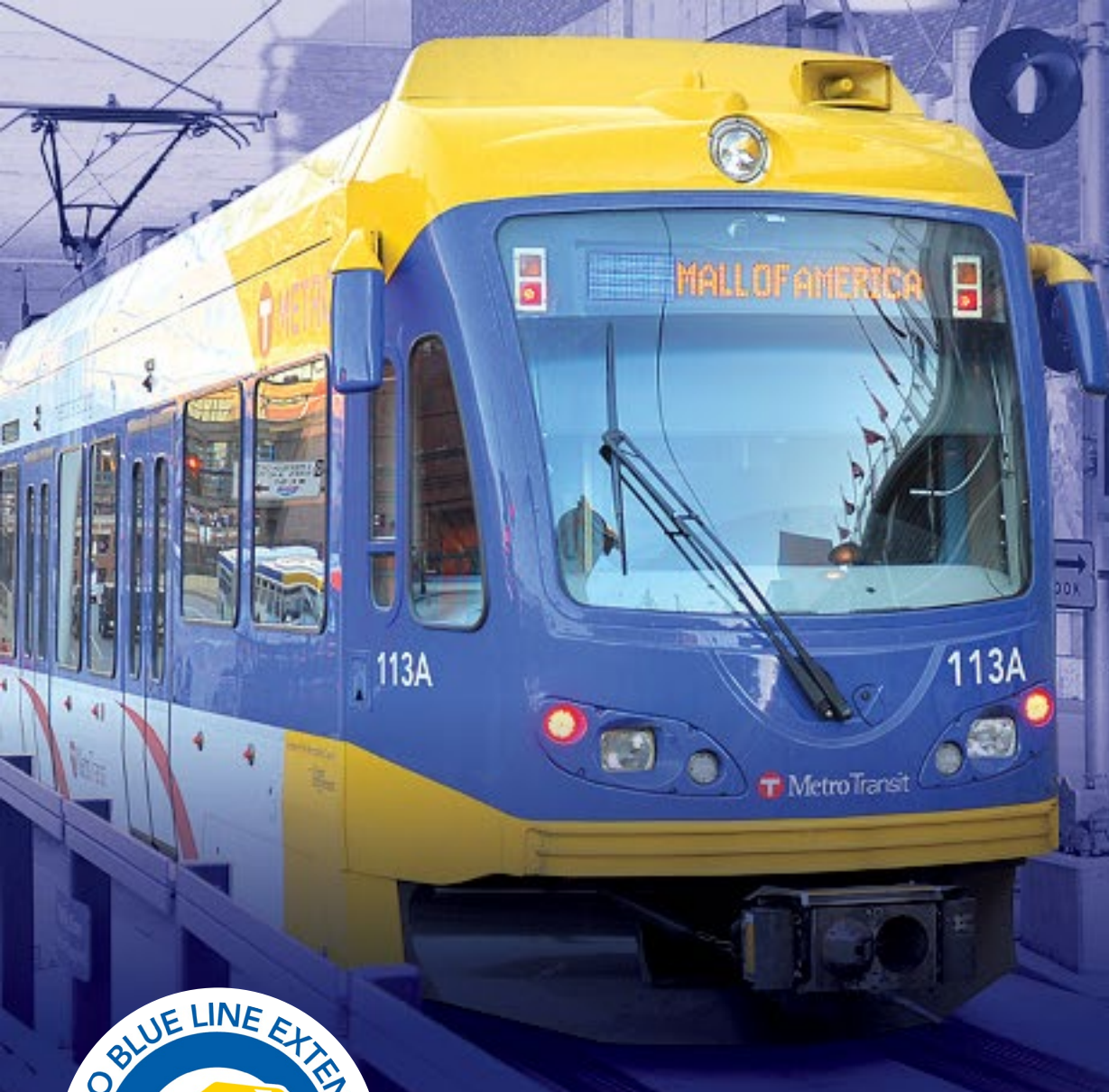

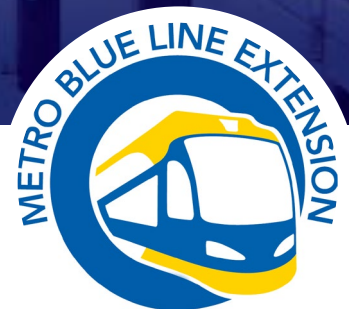

# SDEIS Comment Summary (as of 8/7/2024)

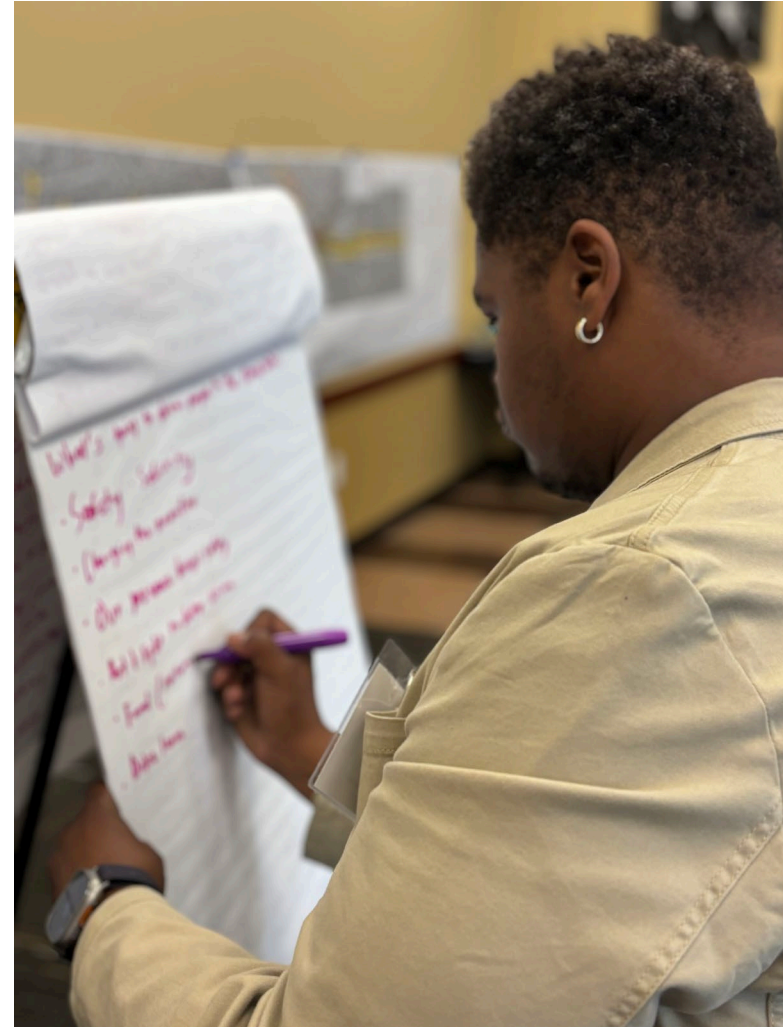

- Anticipated SFEIS publication mid-2025

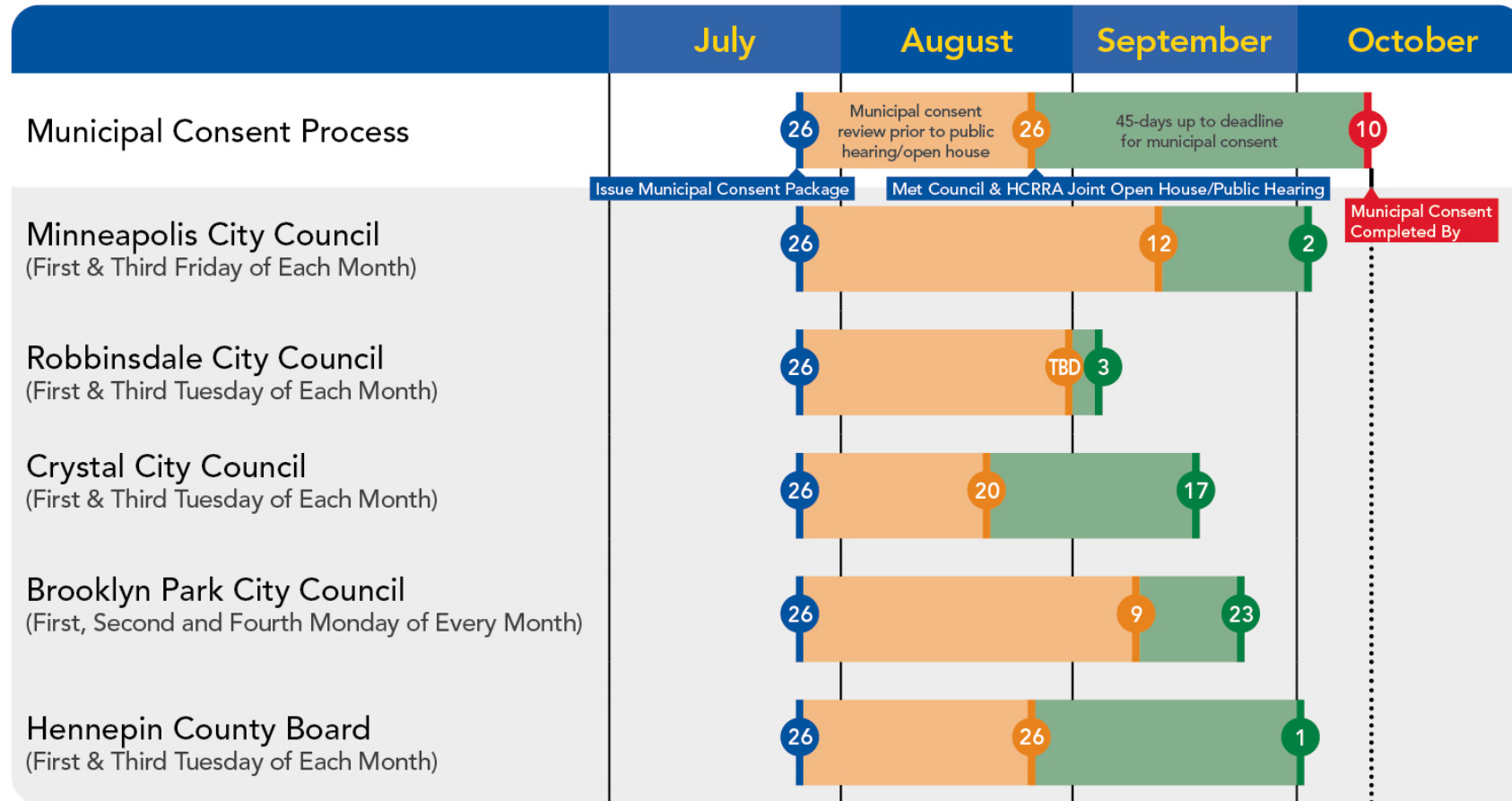
