Wetlands north of Golden Valley Rd have been excavated to enhance stormwater storage collected from adjacent streets. Wetlands south of Golden Valley Rd to Plymouth Ave are mostly connected with Bassett Creek and its backwaters, though some wetlands are isolated ditches associated with construction of the BNSF freight rail tackage.

Wetlands south of Plymouth Ave to Highway 55 are mostly connected with Bassett Creek and its backwaters, though some wetlands are isolated ditches associated with construction of the BNSF freight rail tackage.

Floodplain impacts are generally attributable to the reconstruction of the freight rail alignment in the western half of the corridor and are concentrated around Plymouth Avenue station and extending south to Olson Memorial Highway. This proposed floodplain mitigation site would create the necessary flood storage to offset floodplain impacts.
