LANDSCAPE STATION TYPE



- Located within a natural setting or a gateway to significant natural features
- Architecturally understated and sensitive to its context
- Design engages with natural and recreational features

NEIGHBORHOOD STATION TYPE



- Located within a neighborhood/urban village setting
- Architecturally sensitive to the pedestrian scale of the neighborhood
- Design engages with neighborhood contextual features

TOWN SQUARE STATION TYPE



- Located at a gateway to a major activity center
- Architecturally recognizable as a significant place in the community
- Design enhances public spaces

LANDMARK STATION TYPE



- Located at a community amenity, institution, or major employment area where a station might be less visible
- Architecturally recognizable as a significant destination
- Design enhances the station visibility
