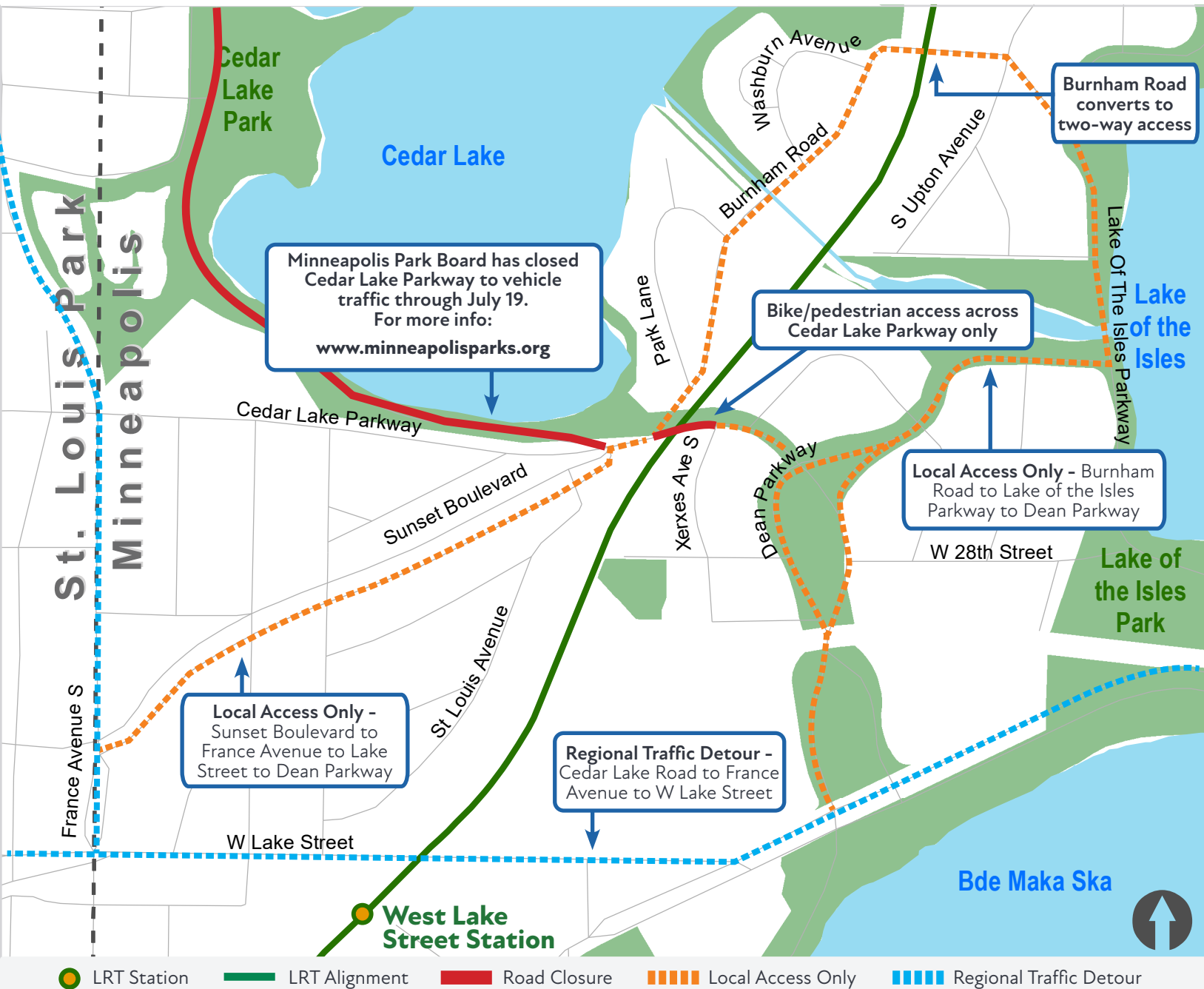


# Southwest Green Line LRT Extension

📍 Minneapolis - Cedar Lake Parkway Detour



## CURRENT AND UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

- ▶ Cedar Lake Parkway will be closed to vehicles from Xerxes Avenue to Burnham Road in Minneapolis starting July 6 for 16 days. Access between Cedar Lake Parkway and Burnham Road will remain open.
- ▶ Pedestrians and bicyclists will have access across the work zone for the entire duration. Access during the closure will be limited to one side of the road and will shift to the south side of the roadway to accommodate the work.
- ▶ Crews will install tunnel sheeting through the intersection and then reestablish the roadway.
- ▶ A future closure lasting six months (minus the duration of this closure) will be needed to excavate and construct the tunnel. Tunnel excavation is anticipated to start later this year, we will provide updates when that work is scheduled.
- ▶ Minneapolis Park Board closed Cedar Lake Parkway to vehicle traffic through July 19. For updates and more info: [www.minneapolisparke.org](http://www.minneapolisparke.org)



## WHAT TO EXPECT

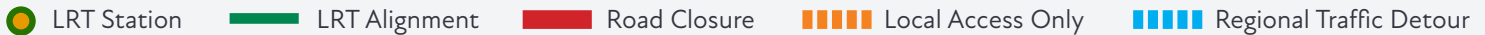
- ▶ Traffic will be detoured:
  - Local Access Only
    - » Sunset Boulevard to France Avenue to Lake Street to Dean Parkway
    - » Burnham Road to Lake of the Isles Parkway to Dean Parkway (Note: Lake of the Isles and Burnham Road will convert to two way access during the closure)
  - Regional Traffic Detour - Cedar Lake Road to France Avenue to W Lake Street
